Getting Started

Step 1 - Select Import Wizard from the File Menu.

Step 2 - Select All items from the **Startup Group** by clicking on each and pressing the Space Bar.

Step 3 - Click the Finish Button

Step 4 - Select Save As from the File Menu

Step 5 - Go to your Windows directory and enter the filename **Common** and press return

Step 6 - Select Compile Script from the File menu

How to Create a New Script

To create a blank script, select New from the File Menu.

How to Save a Script

To save a Script select Save As from the File Menu. If you have already Saved. Select Save from the file menu.

Files Names are Important

Files names that are important. If you save you script with the filename common.sms in the windows directory or in the same location as Startup Magic Interpreter then this is the first script that will run. If you save another script as your computername.sms (computername) is the name of your computer in the network settings this will be run next after this if you save a script as your username.sms (username) is what you logged into windows 95 or NT with. This is run last. All these must be saved in either the windows directory or in the Startup Magic Interpreters directory.

e.g.

c:\windows\common.sms

c:\windows\skynet.sms

c:\windows\danny.sms

How to Open a saved Script

To open a saved Script select Open from the file Menu.

How to Quickly Re-open a Script

A Script that has been opened or saved in the past will be in the Re-open list found in the File Menu. To use this feature, select one of the nine possible items in the Re-open menu.

How to use Import Wizard

What is Import Wizard?

Import wizard looks at your Startup Group and your Run in your Registry and compiles a list of files currently set to run when you start Windows 95. You have the option to select items from this list, which will be used in your current script.

To select a item from the Wizard click with the left mouse button on any item that has this [] on the start. Then press the space bar or double click on the Item. To un-select an item double click it or press the space bar.

When you have finished selecting. Click on the Finish button. This will transfer the links in to a Startup directory in the same location as this program. It will also create backup script so that it can be used to restore the links to their previous location. If you have selected any items from the Run part in the Registry there will be a backup Registry file to restore these to. The backups can be found in the Backup directory where Startup Magic was installed. It will then build a script back in the main part of the program.

How to Compile a Script

Creating a script is not enough Startup Magic Interpreter can not use it until it has been compiled to do this you select Compile Script from the File Menu.

How to Run a Script

To run a script you must compile it first if you have not Startup Magic Developer will do it automatically for you. To run, select Run from the File Menu or press the Ctrl & R keys.

How to Cut

To cut a line or multiple select the lines by holding down the shift key and use the cursor keys up or down. To select individual lines hold the Ctrl key down and click on the lines with the left mouse button. To cut, select Cut from the Edit Menu or press the Ctrl & X keys.

How to Copy

To Copy a line or multiple select the lines by holding down the shift key and use the cursor keys up or down. To select individual lines hold the Ctrl key down and click on the lines with the left mouse button. To Copy, select Copy from the Edit Menu or press the Ctrl & C keys

How to Paste

To paste the line or lines Click on the line you wish to insert and select Paste from the Edit menu or press the Ctrl & V keys.

How to Delete

To delete a line or multiple lines select the lines by holding down the shift key and use the cursor keys up or down. To select individual lines hold the Ctrl key down and click on the lines with the left mouse button. To Delete, select Delete from the Edit Menu or Press the Delete Key.

Control Palette Summary



Load a Program

This button is used to load a application.
Settings are : Load Minimized, Maximized or Hidden.



Menu Developer

This button is used to create a Menu or Individual Startup Magic Scripts.



Wait

This button creates a pause the number of seconds of which are defined by you.



Wait for Load

This button creates a pause at the beginning of your script. The numbers of seconds of which are defined by you.



Locate Script Window

This button is used to change the location of the script window, choose from 9 different locations or choose minimize, hidden or show.



Run Script

This button is used to call another script and when it completed it will return to the original to finish.



Prompt

This button is used to request a Yes & No response for each command in your script.

It can be turned on and off at any position.



Change Desktop

This button is used to change the background image on your desktop. You can pick a single bitmap or random from a directory or random from the windows directory.



No

This button is used to switch off the F8 prompt on or the F5, Quit button on the startup interpreter window.



File Copy

This button is used to copy a single file or a directory and its subdirectories to a destination.



File Delete

This button is used to delete a file.



This button is used to rename a file or a directory.

File Rename



Change Date

This button is used to change the system time.



Show Errors

This button is used to hide any errors reported by Startup Magic interpreter.

It can be turned on or off anywhere in the script.

Filename

Enter the Application you wish to run e.g. **notepad.exe**. You can run associated files e.g. **readme.wri** or you can browse a directory by entering the directory path e.g. **c:\windows**. You can even launch a www page if you are using Internet Explorer e.g. **www.genesoft.demon.co.uk**.

Command Line

The command line is used for any files or switches you wish to launch with your application e.g **c:\my documents\readme.doc /P**.

Window Style

This is used to set the window style of the application you are launching. It works for associated files or exploring a directory, but is ignored if you launch a Short cut link.

Browse

Use this to browse for the file you wish to launch.

Menu Titles

Use this to set the titles of the menu.

E.g.

- Standard Startup
- Virus Kill Startup
- Backup Startup

Menu Scripts

Beside the Menu titles enter the name of the script that you wish to run.

E.g.

- Standard Startup c:\my documents\standard.smc
- Virus Kill Startup c:\my documents\virus.smc
- Backup Startup c:\my documents\backup.smc

Auto Launch 1st Item

If you click the check box next to the Auto Launch and enter a number of second the first item in your menu will be automatically launched after count down.

Run Script

Use this button to browse for your script you have already compiled for the opposite Menu Item.

Wait

Enter a period of second or you can use the cursor keys up or down.

Vertical Placement

Use this to set the vertical location to Top, Center, Bottom

Horizontal Placement

Use this set the horizontal location to Left, Center, Right.

Visible

Use this to hide, show or minimize the Script Window.

Run Script

Use this to call another script and when it has completed it will return to the original to finish.

Prompt

Select yes or no to turn on or off a request Yes & No response for each command in your script.

Browse

Select a bitmap to change your desktop background.

Try

Use this to see the image on your desktop.

Other Options

Use this to turn on the Random Option.

Random in this Directory

Choose this option to select any bitmap in this directory.

Random in the Windows Directory

Choose this option to select any bitmap in the windows directory.

No F5 - Quit Script

Check this to disable the Quit button and the F5 key.

No F8 - Prompt

Check this to disable the manual Prompt when you press the F8 key.

Source

The source is where the file or files will be copied from. You can select a file or a directory. If you select a directory and do not include a back slash '\` at the end then the source directory including the last directory name from the source name will be copied. For example: **c:\windows\system** to the destination **c:\temp**, a directory called system will be created in the temp directory. If you do include a back slash '\`, all the files in source directory are copied to the destination. For example: **c:\windows\system** to the destination **c:\temp** will copy all the files in the system directory to the c:\temp.

Destination

The destination is where the file or files will be copied to. If you are copying a single file then you do not have to include the filename of the destination, for example `c:\windows\readme.txt` to the destination `c:\temp\` the file name will be taken from the source. If you do not include a back slash `\` at the end, and the directory does not exist the file will be copied to the destination name as a file. For example `c:\windows\readme.txt` to `c:\readme`, a file will be created in the `c:\` root called `readme`. If you include a backslash `\` at end then it will try to create that directory. If you are copying a directory and you do not include a backslash at the end, a directory will always be created. You can not copy a directory to a single filename.

Advance

Click on the advance button this will reveal the advanced options. Overwrite All, Overwrite if Newer, Do not Overwrite, Confirm if exists, Do not Copy Sub directories, Overwrite Read only files.

Advance - Overwrite All

Check this option to overwrite all files that exist in the destination.

Advance - Overwrite if newer

Check this option to overwrite only if the destination file is older than the source.

Advance - Do Not Overwrite

Check this option to not write over any file in the destination.

Advance - Confirm if they Exist

Check this option to have a request window display before the file is over written.

Advance - Do not Copy the Subdirectories.

Check this option to not copy the subdirectories when you select a directory to copy as the source.

Advance - Overwrite Read Only Files

Check this option to overwrite Read Only Files.

File Requester

Use this button to select a file using the File Requester. If you wish to copy a directory select a file within the directory you wish to copy and when you click Open just delete the file name from text box.

What to Delete

Enter the name of the file you wish to delete.

File Requester

Use this to select a file using the File Requester.

Source

Enter the name of the file or directory to rename.

Destination

Enter the name of the file or directory to be renamed to.

E.g. from **c:\window\readme.txt** to **c:\windows\readit.txt**

File Requester

Use this button to select a file using the File Requester. If you wish to rename a directory select a file within the directory you wish to rename and when you click Open just delete the file name from text box.

Previous Year

Use this to go to the previous year.

Next Year

Use this to go to the next year.

Previous Month

Use this to go to the previous month.

Next Month

Use this to go to the next month.

Select a Day

Use this to select a day from the month.

Show Errors

Select yes or no to turn on or off the error log.

Goto Today

If you changed the date earlier in the script you can change it back to days date by checking the Goto Today button.

Latest Information

Just as we are about to release this version a problem arrived. It is to do with the Date command it seem that when you change the date the hour sometimes goes on one hour. But instead of holding back the release we fort better just notify you of the problem.

Limitations of this Version.

It is a single user version of the developer the scripts will not function if they are run from a network drive. **Network Version to be released later.**
