Playing WinJack

Upon starting WinJack will shuffle the deck of cards. Betting must be done before dealing the cards by using the BetBar or entering an amount directly from 0 to 100. After which you may deal the cards. The player then hits until he gets close to 21 with out going over. When the player stands the deal will deal his own hand. The dealer will hit on or below 16 and stand on or above 17. The Bet is automatically added or subtracted from the player's assets.

Surrender

This is just like giving up and you'll lose half your bet. You can only surrender at the start of the hand.

Double Down

At the start of the hand you have the option of doubling your bet and taking one and only one additional card.

Split

You can split your hand when you are first dealt two cards of the same value. This then gives you 2 hands to play with while risking the bet amount with each hand. You can only play one hand at a time (the top and MUST be played first). Once you stand or bust on the top hand the next card will be dealt to the second hand.

Using the Mouse

Deal

Left-Click on the deck of cards or on any played card AFTER the hand is done.

Hit

Left-Click on any player cards or on the deck while the hand is being played.

Stand

Left-Click on any dealer card.

Cheat

Right-Click on any Face-down card (Setup option must be checked).

Quick Tabs

Click the tabs at the top of the dialog boxes to switch to another option.

Action Menu

Right-Click any window or dialog background.

You automatically win if you are dealt 5 cards and you haven't busted.

9 10 or 11 only

Allows doublingdown on 9, 10 or 11 only.

About Box at Start

Displays About box at startup of WinJack.

About

Display About dialog box showing version information.

Aces get 1 card only

Splits with a pair of aces will only get one card each.

Allow Surrender

Displays the surrender button at the start of everyhand.

assets

The amount of money the player currently has.

AutoSize

WinJack changes size to allow all cards delt to be shown.

bet

The amount of money risked on one hand.

Burn top card

After a shuffle WinJack burns (throws out) the top card in the deck.

bust

No, it's not that! When the player or dealer's hand is greater than 21 (you lose).

Card Shark

Enable Card Shark.

Card Speed

Changes the speed at which the cards are delt. Higher number is faster.

Card Voice

Calls out the score of each hand as it's dealt.

CardCount

Display Card Count dialogbox.

CardShark

Activate Card Shark.

Cheating Allowed

Allows player to view face-down cards by Right-Clicking the mouse.

Colored Text

Enables Colored text on the ScoreBar.

Deal

Deals the cards for the next hand.

Dealer hits soft 17

The dealer will take a card if his score is 17 and one of his cards is an ace (which at the time is being counted as 11).

Dealer Wins
Dealer wins ties.

Shows the losing hand in an off color.

Allows the use of WinJack extensions for multimedia. The files WINCARDX.DLL and WJWAVE.DLL must be in your WinJack directory. The multimedia extensions are available free when you order WinJack on disk.

MultiMedia

Displays Multi-Media dialogbox.

Number of Decks

Changes the number of decks WinJack uses the next time it shuffles.

Offer Insurance

Enables the insurance dialog box.

Player Wins
Player wins ties.

Resets the player's bank amount to \$1,000.

Rules

Displays the Rules dialogbox.

Same Card only

Allows splits with the same card only, otherwise allows splits with cards of the same value.

Setup

Display Setup dialogbox.

Show dealer's Last Card

The Dealer will show his last card if you bust.

Shuffle

Shuffles the decks of cards.

Software

Instructions for your computer.

Sound

Enables Sound. Your system must suport sound and have a sound card installed.

Split

Splits the player's hand into two.

Splits

Enables Splits.

Stand

Player stops taking cards and the dealer takes his.

Standard

Child window ScoreBar at top of WinJack window.

Statistics

Displays the Statistics dialogbox.

Surrender

Player quits his hand and loses half his bet.

Ties

Nobody wins ties.
