This is a beta version, which takes its designed feature set and interface more or less directly from the application version of WebPainter. Development and feature set refinement are still in progress -- while this version includes basic painting functionality, some features such as Undo are not yet implemented. Completed design work has not yet been done to WebPainter for the OpenDoc environment.

Nevertheless, we feel it to be functional and generally stable editing a standalone document or embedded in a container such as Digital Harbor's WAV word processor, so we are making it publicly available to invite your feedback and design input. Specifically, we'd like to hear exactly how you want to use the OpenDoc version of WebPainter, and how the design needs to be changed or what capabilities we need to add to make it a valuable solution to you. On the other hand, if it is useful to you as it is, we'd like to hear that too and what you're using it for.
