Introduction

TitleTime adds the current date and/or time, including "Swatch Internet Time" (usefull or not), to the Caption of the currently active application window. The date- and time-format can be configured to use regional date and time formats.

It is also possible to set three alarms and to choose different weekdays at which the alarms have to occur. When the alarms occur, **TitleTime** opens an "[Alarm window](#)" with a user-definable picture and/or executes resp. opens programs, wave-files or documents.

TitleTime is accessible from the [System Tray](#) and includes general options to ShutDown, Reboot and LogOff Windows. It is recommended to add a Shortcut to the Startup Group.

The following windows will not display the date and/or time (disabled):

- all standard "Open"- and "Save As"-windows
(and all other windows with Class Name #32770 like WinTop, RegClean, ...)
- MS Excel and MS Word "Open"- and "Save As"-windows
- MS Visual Basic 4 "sub"-windows
- MS DOS-windows
- Explorer windows in "Open"-view, because DoubleExplore:

Install

1. Extract TiTime.zip to a folder of your choice, but choose a folder with a short name (not more than eight characters).
2. Right-click on TiTime.inf, choose "Install".
3. Delete the extracted files.

For updates: You can install this version above older 1.xx versions.

Additional files: TitleTime requires the following additional system files. If you don't find them in your system-directory (e.g. c:\windows\system), you can download the files:

- **msvcrt40.dll** - **olepro32.dll** - **vb40032.dll** - **ven2232.olb** - (zipped 615 KB) from:

- **comctl32.ocx** (at least v5.01.4319) - (zipped 228 KB) from:

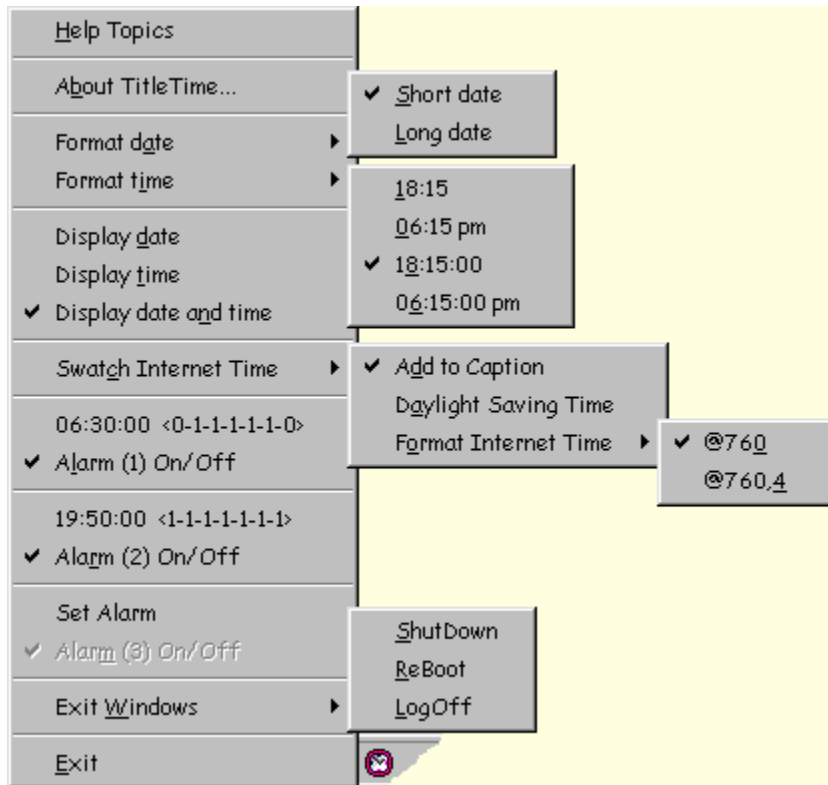

The Tray Menu



Click into the picture (the mouse cursor will change) to get more information.

Format date

Choose how you want to display the date (short or long). The format depends on your settings in Control Panel / Regional Settings.

Format time

Choose how you want to display the time. The separator for hours, minutes and seconds and the designation for morning and afternoon times depends on your settings in Control Panel / Regional Settings.

Swatch Internet Time

Add to Caption

Check this option to add the "Swatch Internet Time" to all Captions.

Daylight Saving Time

If your country uses the Daylight Saving Time in summer, you have to check this option during this time period.

Format Internet Time

Choose how you want to display the "Swatch Internet Time" (with or without "Centibeats").

Alarm (n) On/Off (n = 1-3)

Enables resp. disables the alarm.

(Disabled when the alarm has not been set.)

Set Alarm

Choosing this Menu item opens the "Alarmsettings Window" to set the alarm.

Menu item title when the alarm is not set: "Set Alarm"

Menu item title when the alarm is set: The alarm time and the days at which the alarm has to occur.
(0 = day unchecked; 1 = day checked)

Tray Icon

Left-Click: Enables resp. disables the date and/or time display in all Captions. Alarms will still work.
Right-Click: Opens the Tray Menu
Double-Click: Executes NewFolder32 (if installed)

The Alarmsettings Window



Click into the picture (the mouse cursor will change) to get more information.

Alarm time

Choose the time (hour and minute) on which the alarm has to occur.

Alarm days

Choose the days at which the alarm has to occur.

Alarm text / Picture

The text and picture you enter resp. choose here will be displayed in the "Alarm Window" when the alarm occur. The corresponding CheckBox enables resp. disables this option.

(The CheckBox must be checked to enter text or choose a picture.)

Execute / Parameter

The program (with the defined parameter(s)), wave-file or document you choose here will be executed resp. opened when the alarm occur. The corresponding CheckBox enables resp. disables this option.

(The CheckBox must be checked to choose a file or enter a parameter.)

The Alarm Window



Click into the picture (the mouse cursor will change) to get more information.

Alarm time

The time as chosen in the "Alarmsettings Window".

Alarm text

The text as entered in the "Alarmsettings Window".

Alarm picture

The picture as chosen in the "Alarmsettings Window".
