## INSTALLATION

It's somewhat simple: Copy the file ATOFFICE.SCR to your Windows directory. From your CONTROL PANEL, select DISPLAY then the Screensaver tab.

Scroll down until you see the ATOFFICE screensaver. Select it. Now, let me explain something: This screensaver was developed using a multimedia application called ASTOUND. When you select ATOFFICE, the box below will ALWAYS open up by default. **IGNORE IT** and **Just press Exit**. Do make sure to adjust the amount of minutes you want before the screensaver activates The Preview and Settings buttons that might normally be available for most screensavers will always bring up this box. Then select OKAY and exit the Display Properties window. Your screensaver will now run.
