

Appendix A: Best of Breed Cross Platform

An important factor with any corporate decision to use a comprehensive product like IE 4.0 is its ability to operate across different platforms. A key differentiator between IE 4.0 and Netscape Communicator is that Microsoft's product targets a best-of-breed strategy optimized for each platform, versus the single, least common denominator approach taken by Netscape.

Internet Explorer 3.0 has the greatest support for native OS technologies, like Internet Config and JManager on the Apple Macintosh, allowing it to run in as little as 4 MB of RAM versus 16MB for Netscape Navigator. Because of this best-of-breed strategy, IE 3.0 for the Mac has won rave reviews and is quickly taking away market share from Netscape. Internet Explorer 3.0 on Windows 3.1 provides the widest support for the latest web technologies, such as ActiveX, Java, Authenticode, PICS, and more.

Although Netscape has developed their products for a wider array of OS platforms than Microsoft, the majority of them are used by relatively few people. Once the Unix version of Internet Explorer 3.0 is available, Internet Explorer will be available on the vast majority of personal computer platforms. Microsoft plans to meet its customers needs best by focusing on providing the most important features with stable and optimized code for the platforms most people are using.

Microsoft will develop IE 4.0 for the Macintosh, Windows 3.1, and other platforms. But because Internet Explorer 3.0 was developed as a componentized architecture using ActiveX, and because it supports the broadest array of web technologies now, it can be used with the latest version – IE 4.0 – without integration problems. Corporations needing to roll-out a cross-platform intranet solution can feel safe about using the current version, Internet Explorer 3.0, on their Macintosh, Windows 3.1, and Unix platforms, in conjunction with IE 4.0 on their Windows 95/NT machines. Customers are assured they can easily upgrade from Internet Explorer 3.0 to 4.0 and exploit all the enhanced capabilities of IE 4.0, once it becomes available on a particular OS platform.
