Welcome,

We all know that there are a lot of Back to the Future Fans out there and if you downloaded this then you must be one of them. I hope that you will find this theme to be entertaining.

Installation:

To use this theme you need to be running the Theme package that comes with Microsoft Plus for Windows 95. Just unzip the downloaded file "Back to the Future Theme.zip" to your Themes directory (usually: C:\PROGRAM FILES\PLUS\THEMES). Make sure you use WinZip 6.X or something else that supports long filenames. What you should end up with is the theme file "Back to the Future 16-bit.theme" in your THEMES directory with a subdirectory called "BTTF Theme" which contains all the sound files, cursors and wallpaper.

Once this is done then you can activate your desktop themes icon from the control panel and select the Back to the Future Theme from the list. Enjoy! This theme looks best at 800 x 600 pixel resolution with 16-bit color. I think there are some good sound files here.

De-Installation:

If you are unhappy with this theme and just plain don't want it anymore then you can easily remove it by deleting the "Back to the Future 16-bit.Theme" and the subdirectory "BTTF Theme" both from your "...Program Files\Plus\Themes" directory.
