Comments : If you're booting with an BigBen infected disk the virus allocates fast memory and copies itself into this area and changes the CoolCapture to stay resident in memory. For infection the virus patches the DoIO() vector from the exec.library additionally the virus patches the WaitPort() and the ReplyMsg() Vector. This vectors are just used to initialize the DoIO() routine.

After 3 resets the virus brings up a DIGITAL-WATCH while you're booting.

virus. Push left mouse button to return.

You can't find any message in the bootblock.

The virus itself is a very primitive one but the "Digital-watch-Routine" is very well coded.
