# Virus Info Base

### 1.1 Saddam Hussein

Way to infect: L/Disk-validator (if not found the virus makes one)

Rating : Dangerous

Kickstarts : 1.2/1.3

Damage : Destroys block by overwriting

Manifestation: Mouse pointer disappears and DisplaysAlert

Comments : The Saddam Hussein virus destroys blocks by overwriting data with "IRAK" and sets Bitmap NOT VALID (so running the disk-Validator next time will infect your system).

Starts disk-head stepping in all floppy drives and writes on disk (if writeable)

The mouse pointer disappears and and you will ge a an alert with text "SADDAM VIRUS". On pressing the mouse button, a cold reset will be started.
