How to use WinAmp List Manager

In order to use this program you must have downloaded the MP3 and Module standard: WinAmp. You can download it at: <http://www.winamp.com>

The first time you use WinAmp Playlist Manager you must go to "preferences" and configurate the program. Once you've done this, you are ready to use the program. If you right-click on a button you can choose to edit the list. If you do this you can create a new Playlist in multiple file formats. If you now click on the button, WinAmp will start playing your playlist. In stead of creating your own playlist, you can load an existing playlist, that you have created with WinAmp or any other program. Click on the button and it will start.

Right-click on the button again and you can edit the button's name. lets say that you have selected all MP3 files from the CD: "Club X 3", then it would be wise to name the button: "Club X 3".

What's the program good for ?

The reason why I made this program is that there was no simple utility that would work like a little remote control for MP3 and Module collections. I have lots of playlists that I want to listen to, and switch to another list easily. If I could have a little (Always-On-Top)-remote control for that, it would be very nice... That's why I made this.
