

#### **Version 2.1.6 (October 30, 2008)**

- Significant performance improvements on shadow generation algorithm
- Fixed a minor issue with capturing non-rectangular windows
- Various other stability and performance improvements

#### **Version 2.1.5 (August 5, 2008)**

- Fixed an issue with capturing WindowBlinds themes on Windows XP
- Some minor improvements on custom dialog controls under different OS

#### **Version 2.1.4 (June 24, 2008)**

- New: Installer for 64-bit versions of Windows XP/Vista
- Installers are now multilingual with full Unicode support ([www.scratchpaper.com](http://www.scratchpaper.com))
- A better algorithm to determine the window size of non-rectangular windows
