This is a demonstration version of the Tapestry Web browser from Frontier Technologies Corporation. The Tapestry application supports many different protocols including a World Wide Web (WWW) Browser, Gopher+ Browser, WAIS, CSO Phone Book, and basic FTP, and is fully Windows Sockets compliant.

Tapestry comes with a default Internet Organizer with many preconfigured Internet resources available to you. If you do not find the resources you want to access in the Internet Organizer, you can easily add additional items to the Internet Organizer as you find them on the Internet by using drag and drop from the Gopher Tree View window, the WWW Browser window or by using the File|Connect menu item. This menu item allows you to simply type in the hostname and the type of protocol to use, or you can enter a complete Uniform Resource Locator (URL).

Standard Installation

The Tapestry application is a Windows Sockets compliant application that is self-contained in a single self-extracting ZIP archive. Simply extract the files into a directory and add the file WINTAP32.EXE to your program group.

If you are already running a release version of Tapestry, or a previous demo version, you can upgrade that version with this one if this version (v 2.04) is newer. It is recommended that you extract the files to a different directory than the one in which you have installed your Frontier product (usually, C:\SUPERTCP) and then copy the remaining files **except the file called BOOKMARK.BMF** to your install directory. If you copy the file BOOKMARK.BMF to your install directory, your Organizer contents will be overwritten, and any bookmarks you have added will be lost!

Also, be sure that you have shut down all Frontier applications before copying the files to your install directory, or some files may not be copied. If you are running Windows 95, you should shut down Windows and Restart in MS-DOS mode to ensure that no programs are running when you do the update.

Requirements

Tapestry requires Windows 95 or Windows NT and a Windows Sockets compliant TCP/IP stack. Tapestry contains an internal viewer for images in twelve of the most popular image formats, including GIF and JPEG. Other file types will require external programs for viewing/playing. See the online documentation for details.

For full documentation, including context sensitive help, press the F1 key at any time.
