To use this reference:

Abbreviations used in this reference:

Sh Shift Bksp ... Backspace
^ Control Spcbr... Spacebar
Alt Alt db dialog box

To print the information on a screen:

Select Print Topic from the File menu of this Help file.

To return to the main PhotoStyler Help file:

Click the Contents button on the ribbon along the top of this screen.

Files/Workspace: Manage image files and your workspace.

Tools: Access and use tools quickly.

Viewing: Add views and control zoom.

Selections/Masks: Create and edit selections and masks.

Editing and Transforming: Cut, copy, paste, rotate, distort, etc.

Paint/Enhance: Tools and commands for painting and enhancing.

If a dialog box obstructs the view of the image:

To alter the selection (while a selection tool is active):

Add to selection Sh & make selection
Remove from selection ... ^ & make selection
Intersection Sh^ & make selection
Deselect selection right mouse button

While still holding the left mouse button, press Bksp.
