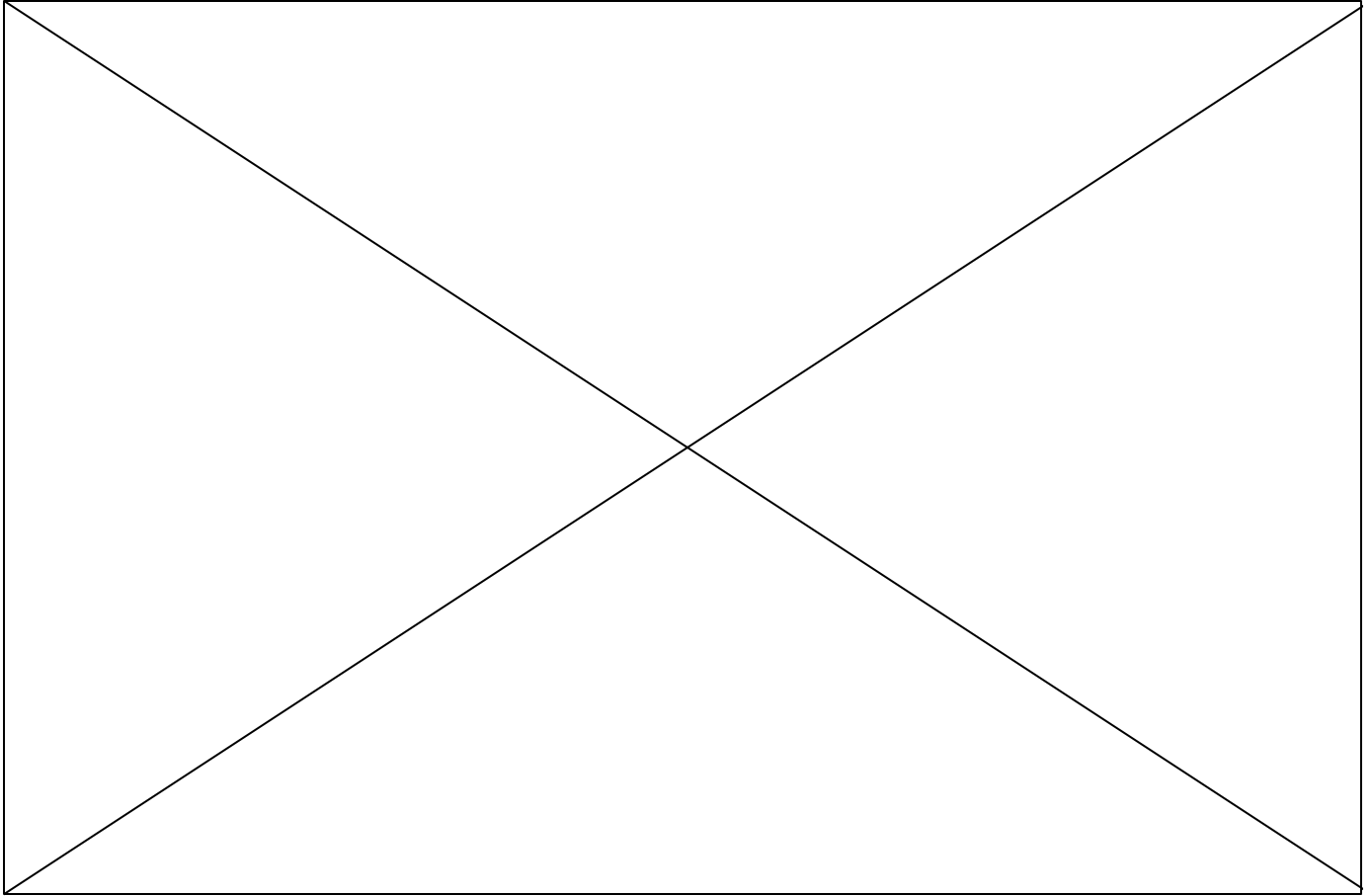


A/UX Software Update Service

The A/UX[®] operating system can provide a powerful, interactive working environment for you and your company. To enhance that environment, Apple wants to ensure that you get the updates you need to keep your system working optimally--now and in the future.

The A/UX Software Update Service provides a convenient way for you to receive new versions of A/UX software and related documentation as soon as they are released by Apple. For an annual fee, the A/UX Software Update Service provides all software updates released within a one-year period. You may renew the service for additional one-year periods.

Updates provide product enhancements, system revisions, and all the necessary documentation, including a description of new features and installation procedures. A/UX updates may be used only on Apple[®] Macintosh[®] personal computers that have been licensed to use A/UX.
