The following changes have not been included in the *MacWrite II, Version 1.1 Installation and New Features Guide*.

The Claris Help System

The Claris™ Help System file (MacWrite® II Help disk) is referred to on page 14 of the *Installation and New Features Guide* as Claris Help. The correct name is the Claris Help System. As explained in the Installation Guide, the Claris Help System file and the MacWrite II Help file must be installed in the same folder (Claris folder or System Folder) to use the Claris Help System.

The Claris Help System now supports cut and paste operations from within the MacWrite II Help System or from any HyperCard stack. For more information on cutting and pasting, refer to the About Help section in the MacWrite II Help System.

To open a HyperCard stack from within the Help system:

- 1. Choose Help from the Apple menu to open the MacWrite II Help System.**
- 2. Press Command-M to display the Message box.**
- 3. Type "Go" (no quotation marks) in the Message box and press Return.**

The "Where is ?" dialog box appears.

- 4. Locate the stack you want to open.**
- 5. Select the name and click OK.**

WordPerfect 4.2 PC File Translator

If a file appears in the Open or Insert File dialog box, MacWrite II automatically selects a file format and opens the file using the appropriate translator. However, if you want to open a WordPerfect 4.2 PC file, you must first choose WordPerfect PC 4.2 from the Show pop-up menu. Do not choose "All available." WordPerfect 4.2 files cannot be distinguished from ordinary text files.

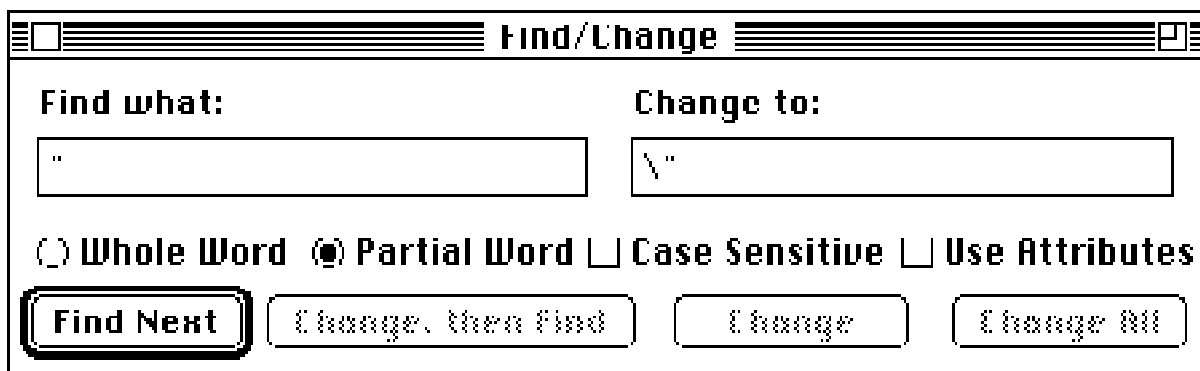
Note: With WordPerfect 5.0 PC files, you can use the "All available" option.

Find/Change

You can now find plain quotes and change them to Smart Quotes (and vice versa) quickly and easily using special characters in the Find/Change dialog box.

To change plain quotes to Smart Quotes:

- 1. Choose Find/Change from the Edit menu.**
- 2. In the Find/Change dialog box, enter a double quote (") in the "Find what" box and a back slash and double quote (\") in the "Change to" box, as shown below.**



- 3. Click the Find Next button to find the first double quote.**
- 4. Click Change All to convert all plain double quotes to curly double quotes.**

Using the Find/Change dialog box, you can follow the same procedure to change single quotes:

<u>Find what/Change to:</u>	<u>Type:</u>	<u>Appears in Box:</u>
" or "	Command-"	\"
' or '	Command-'	\'
