

# QuickTime 4 FAQ

## Q. What is QuickTime?

**A.** In its simplest form, QuickTime is software that allows you to play and edit digital video as well as other types of media on your computer. It is the standard, cross-platform, multimedia environment for authoring, publishing, and streaming the most popular formats of digital video and audio.

## Q. Who uses QuickTime?

**A.** QuickTime appeals to novice as well as advanced power users across a wide range of disciplines, including multimedia artists, musicians, tools developers, educators, marketing executives, and anyone who wants to watch real-time streaming video, listen to MP3 files, and create presentations on either a PC or a Macintosh.

## Q. What are the key features of QuickTime 4?

**A.** QuickTime 4 adds a vast array of new capabilities to QuickTime 3, including the following:

- The QuickTime Player, which features advanced audio and video controls, one-click access to your favorite movies, and a new, easy-to-use interface.
- Real-time, standards-based streaming over the Internet for live and stored audio and video files.
- The updated QuickTime Plug-in, a web browser plug-in that recognizes more than 60 popular media types from within Microsoft Internet Explorer, Netscape Navigator, and America Online.
- An intelligent installer that downloads new features and updates to QuickTime 4 as needed.
- Support for popular Internet file formats including MP3 and Flash. In addition, Java applets can directly access the robust QuickTime API (application program interface) using QuickTime for Java.

# Q. What is QuickTime 4 Pro?

**A.** QuickTime 4 Pro is an enhanced version of QuickTime 4 that allows you to create, edit, and save movies, pictures, and audio on your computer. QuickTime 4 Pro unlocks these powerful capabilities and more in the three included applications: the QuickTime Player, PictureViewer, and the QuickTime Plug-in.

## Q. How much does QuickTime 4 cost?

- **A.** The costs are as follows:
- QuickTime 4 (playback only) is free for all users.
- QuickTime 4 Pro (for editing and saving files and changing file formats) is \$29.99.
  All QuickTime 3 Pro users get the QuickTime 4 Pro upgrade at no charge simply by installing QuickTime 4.
- A convenient, cost-effective multiuser license for 25 or more users is available; call 1-800-747-7483 for information.

## Q. What are the system requirements for QuickTime 4?

A. The requirements are as follows:

## Windows-based systems

- A PC with an Intel or compatible processor or any MPC2-compliant PC (minimum 66-MHz 486 processor; also supports Pentium, Pentium Pro, Pentium II with MMX, and Pentium III processors)
- Pentium processor recommended when using effects, 3D, Sorenson Video, DV, streaming, or QDesign music
- At least 16MB of RAM
- Windows 95, Windows 98, or Windows NT 4.0 system software
- Sound Blaster or compatible sound card and speakers
- DirectX version 3.0 or later recommended

# Mac OS-based systems

- A 68020, 68030, or 68040 processor-based computer or Power Macintosh computer
- Power Macintosh computer required when using 3D, Floating-Point Audio, DV, MPEG, streaming, or QDesign music
- At least 8MB of RAM recommended for 68020, 68030, and 68040 processor-based computers; at least 16MB of RAM recommended for Power Macintosh computers
- Mac OS 7.1 or later
