### **Running Road Rash**

Go to the Start menu and select RUN. There you will select BROWSE, click on the Road Rash icon at your cd-rom drive location. Then open the Road Rash directory. Here you will click on DEMORASH and the game will start up. You then want to go straight to the RESTROOM and select CONFIGURE INPUT. Here you can select which keyboard or joystick settings you prefer. Once this is completed, you should select GAME MODE. Here you can either try out our THRASH MODE (Single player) game. If you need to install Direct X2, you will browse the DIRECT X directory on the cd and click on the DIRECTX setup icon.
