DJ Master is a full-featured digital audio player for Windows 95.

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***DJ Master* was created by Sandro Cumerlato 1993-1998.**

Registration Key granting the full use of all the functions in *DJ Master*, only be used on a single machine at any given time. By entering a registration key that unlocks the program you are agreeing to this license. Registration key can only be given out by the Author.

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General Features:

DJ Master is a digital audio player for Windows 95. You can use it to play PCM Wav files in a wide variety of modes, mix them together, and create Your play list.

But *DJ Master* is much more than just a player: it's like a Disk Jockeys inside your computer. You can work on multiple files simultaneously. You can "Play Up" your audio files with just a click of Your mouse. You can even adjust the BPM (tempo) of your audio with the Pitch Control. When you find just the Pitch you want, you can Mix down Your composition in Real Time.

DJ Master also offers powerful tools. The Mixer Controls gives you a multi-channel mixer, with it You can control the volume of Your Devices. You can set Your hardware with the Preferences Setup and the Device Checker gives you information on Your hardware.

Sounds complicated? Don't worry; *DJ Master* is also easy to use. You can quickly learn how to navigate the main screen, and *DJ Master* offers a variety of keyboard and mouse shortcuts. If you get into trouble or can't figure out how to do something, just look at the Help Contents, or send an email to qme@pluto.dic.unipd.it

Above all, *DJ Master* is fun! Once you've played with it for a while, you'll see how it got its name.

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DJ Master Rules:

The DEMO version of *DJ Master* isn't 100% usable, You can't SAVE/LOAD Play List or Effects Bank, and sometimes *DJ Master* CLICK a bit. These are not BUGS, these are simple LIMITATIONS.

How To Register:

If You want to register *DJ Master* then Fill the Registration Form [Menu: Help - Register...] and then Press "OK"..., Now get the file named "DJMaster.dat" from Your *DJ Master* Install Directory and send it by E-mail to: qme@pluto.dic.unipd.it as an attachment file.

DJ Master costs 39 US\$, when You register You'll get the last available version with a personal key that unlocks all limitations. Registration fee enables You to use *DJ Master* with one computer only. This means that if You try to run it on a machine which is different from the one where you created the .DAT file, then *DJ Master* doesn't work.

If You want to use *DJ Master* with more than one computer, You must send me more than one .DAT file (every one must be created in each machine). Every "additional licence" (corresponding to each additional .DAT) will take 10 US\$ more.

Upgrades of the program will be freely available for registered users, but only within the same version (2.x). Not over the new release (3.0)! You'll get them thru E-mail monthly. Registered users will get the new release of the program at special price.

You may submit your payment in US\$ using an "International Money Order" addressed to "Cumerlato Sandro". Amounts of money not corresponding the registration fee will not be refund.
