Looking things up

Here are four ways to look up something in Guinness:

Pretty sure you know where your subject would be covered?

Click the <u>Browse Records</u> button on the <u>Main Toolbar</u> or <u>Features screen</u> and scroll through the alphabetical list of records. Click a title to read that record.

Not sure of what record would cover your subject?

You may want to do a <u>Word Search</u>. Click the Word Search button on the Main Toolbar or Features screen, type in a word, and click search. *Guinness* will prepare a list of records that contain the word you typed. Scroll to and double-click a record title, and *Guinness* will bring you to the record where your subject appears.

Maybe you're not exactly sure what you're interested in researching.

You may want to use <u>Topics</u> to see the main topics of records in *Guinness*. Click the Topics button on the Main Toolbar or Features screen. Double-click topics on the right side of the screen to go further and further into a subject until you see a record of interest. Double-click a record title to read that record.

You may want to use the <u>Random Record Explorer</u>. Click the Random Record Explorer button on the Main Toolbar or Features screen and watch until you see a picture or record that you want to read about. Click the <u>Record button</u> on the <u>Button bar</u> to view the information.

Access the Grolier Bulletin Board Service by modem 24 hours a day.



Select Pictures from the <u>Main Toolbar</u> or <u>Features screen</u> to see the main topics of pictures in <u>Guinness</u>. To move to the beginning of the Picture index double-click the words Picture Index in the left-hand window. Double-click topics in the right-hand window to go further and further down a "branch" of topics until you see a picture title of interest. The left-hand window will show the path you have taken. You can double-click a topic from the left-hand window at any time to return to that place in the index.

Double-click a picture title to view the picture, or select the picture and click the View button. The picture's caption will appear beneath it. Click the <u>Print button</u> or <u>Save to Disk</u> buttons, if available, to print a picture or to save it to disk.

Close the picture by double-clicking the <u>Control menu</u> of the picture window. The right-hand window will show the record(s) associated with the picture. The left-hand window will contain a list of all of the records that have pictures associated with them. The record that you chose will be highlighted.

Click the Pictures button on the Main Toolbar to return to your place in the Picture Index.

Watching a movie



Click the Movies button on the <u>Main Toolbar</u> or the <u>Features screen</u>. An index of all of the movie categories in <u>Guinness</u>, sorted by subject, will appear. Double-click a subject, and then double-click a movie title, to <u>play a movie</u>.

Note: If you are viewing a record that has a movie associated with it, the Movie button will appear on the <u>Button bar</u>.

Random Record Explorer



The Random Record Explorer allows you to browse records at random. Click the Random Record Explorer button on the <u>Main Toolbar</u> or <u>Features Screen</u> and the Random Record Explorer will begin playing. Each Random Record will be displayed for about 3 seconds. You can change the interval between records by selecting <u>Preferences</u> on the File menu.



- Click the button to play/stop the Random Record Explorer.



- Click the button to speed step through the Random Records.



- Click the button to go back to the previous Random Record.



- Click the button on the Button bar to set the rate at which Random Records are displayed. The default rate is 5 seconds.
- Click the Random Record Explorer button on the Toolbar to restart after viewing a record.

File menu

The following commands are available from the File menu:

Save Print Preferences Exit

Preferences

Preferences (under the File menu) allows you to customize the 1995 Guinnes Multimedia Disc of Records.

You can set the amount of time for which a Random Record is displayed. Records may be displayed from 1 - 60 seconds (the default time is 3 seconds).

You may disable or enable the registration message, opening animation, or Features screen. To disable the registration message or initial animation, click the check-box preceding each item. (If there is a check in the check-box the item will display each time you start <u>Guinness</u>.) You can also choose between the <u>Features screen</u> or the Toolbar interface by clicking the box preceding either item.

Your preferences will be saved when you exit Guinness.

Exit

Select this command to exit *Guinness*.

This selection gives you an alphabetical index of the 3600+ records in Guinness.

Finding a record

Click the Browse Records button on the <u>Main Toolbar</u> or <u>Features Screen</u>. Use the scroll bar to move to the desired record in the index. Double-click the record title to view it.

Note: When you choose Browse Records, *Guinness* will display the last record that you viewed in the right-hand window and its place in the index in the left-hand window.



Word Search helps you find references to a word or set of words in *Guinness*.

Click the Word Search button on the Main Toolbar or Features Screen and type in your search term(s).

Simple Search

The simplest way to use Search is to enter a single word. Click the Search button and *Guinness* will list all of the items that contain the word. Double-click an item's title to see it.

Complex Search

<u>Operators and wild cards</u> may be used to limit or broaden your Search. The Boolean AND, OR, and NOT operators can be used with multiple Search Terms. Wild Cards are helpful if you don't know the spelling of a particular word, and for finding words close in spelling to your Search Term.

Start Over

This button resets the search, erasing all Search Terms and resetting any operators or other options you have changed.

Operators and Wild Cards

OPERATORS

And lets you search for two or more words in a single record (each Search Term must appear in the record at least once). Type the words on separate lines and select Search.

Or lets you search for two or more words in a single record (at least one Search Term must appear in the record). Type the first Search Term, click the Or button, and type the second Search Term on the same line. This procedure may be repeated to further broaden your search.

Not lets you search for the presence of a word/combination of words in the absence of another/others. Type the first Search Term, click the Not button, click in the second line, and type the second Search Term. This procedure may be repeated to further narrow your search.

WILD CARDS

Wild Card (single character)

This will find all instances where your Search Term plus any single letter forms a word (e.g., QUOT? would locate "quota" and "quote"). Type a question mark ("?") at any location in the Search Term.

Wild Card (multiple characters)

This will find all instances where your Search Term plus any number of letters forms a word (e.g., QUOT* would locate "quota," "quotation," "quoted," "quotes," etc.). Type an asterisk ("*") at the end of your Search Term.



The Topic index lets you explore <u>Guinness</u> by subject, gradually refining your search from a broad topic through subtopics to individual records on your subject.

Select Topics by clicking the Topics button on the <u>Main Toolbar</u> or <u>Features Screen</u>. To move to the beginning of the Topic Index double-click the words Topic Index in the left-hand window. Double-click an item in the right-hand window to view a subindex or record.

As you open subindexes, the path you have taken will be displayed in the left-hand window. Simply double-click any subindex to move back to that level.

When you open a record, it is displayed in the right-hand window. A list of all other records within the index is displayed in the left-hand window. Simply click these record titles to display them.

Click the Topics button on the Main Toolbar or Features screen to return to your place in the index.



The Superlative index lets you explore *Guinness* using terms such as "tallest," "longest," etc.

Select Superlatives by clicking the Superlatives button on the <u>Main Toolbar</u> or <u>Features</u> <u>Screen</u>. To move to the beginning of the Superlative index double-click the words Superlative Index in the left-hand window. Double-click a superlative in the right-hand window to list all of the records that relate to it. Double-click a record title, or select View, to read the record.

When you open a record, it is displayed in the right-hand window. The titles of the other records in the Superlative index are displayed in the left-hand window. Simply click these record titles to display them.

Click the Superlatives button on the Main Toolbar to return to your place in the index.

Closing a movie

To close a movie window, double-click the Control menu at the top left corner of the movie window, or choose Close from the <u>Control menu</u> (Alt-F4).

Changing the volume

Click and hold the speaker button (if active) at the left side of the control bar and drag the fader to the desired level.

Moving one frame at a time

Click the forward step button or the backward step button at the right side of the control bar.

If the movie is playing, it will stop and then move one frame forward or backward.

Moving to a different part of the movie

Drag the slider at the bottom of the movie window rightward to advance within a movie. Drag it leftward to go backward.

Stopping a movie

Click the Pause button at the left side of the control bar (the button changes to a Play symbol).

Starting a movie

Click the Play button at the left side of the control bar (the button changes to a Pause symbol).

Sometimes $\underline{Guinness}$ has background information about a set of records. This information can be accessed by clicking the Notes button on the $\underline{Button\ bar}$.



Click this button (if active) on the $\underline{\text{Button bar}}$ to view a picture or a list of pictures illustrating the open record.



Click the Movie button (if active) on the <u>Button bar</u> to <u>watch a movie</u> about the open record.



Click the Stop/Start button to stop or restart the Random Record Explorer.



Moves you to the next item.



Moves you to the previous item.



From the <u>Random Record Explorer</u>, click this button to view more information on a Random Record.


Guinness

Guinness is short for the 1995 Guinness Multimedia Disc of Records.

Features screen

This first screen lists the main features in *Guinness*. To access any feature from this screen, simply select it. To return to the Features screen from within a feature, select the Features button on the $\underline{\text{Main Toolbar}}$. To access the Main Toolbar from the Features screen simply click the $\underline{\text{Go to Toolbar button}}$.

Control Menu



Print

Select Print from the File menu to print the picture or record you are currently viewing. Note: You may also use the <u>Print button</u> from the picture window to print a picture.

Save

Select Save from the File menu to save the picture or record you are currently viewing.

Note: You may also use the <u>Save to disk</u> button from the picture window to save a picture.

Guess What?

The 1995 Guinness Multimedia Disc of Records contains a new feature called Guess What? This feature enables you to browse through some of the most interesting records in Guinness, and to test your knowledge of them.

Simply select Guess What? from the <u>Features screen</u>, <u>Main Toolbar</u>, or Features menu. A list of questions will appear in the left-hand window. Scroll through the list using the scrollbar (or use the <u>Next</u> and <u>Previous</u> buttons) until you have found a question of interest. Once you select a question (by clicking it) you can select Answer or Go to Record. If you select Answer, the Answer will appear in the right-hand window. Selecting Go to Record will bring you to the record that the question is associated with.

Click the Cancel button or double-click the <u>Control menu</u> (or type Alt-F4) to close Guess What? and return to the Features screen or Main Toolbar.

You can use the BBS to send our Technical Support team messages concerning any problems you encounter. In most cases, you will receive a response to your question within one working day. To read our response to you, simply call the BBS the next day. If we have responded, you will automatically be notified at the time you connect.

Please remember the ID and PASSWORD you use when you leave us your message. In order to receive your reply, you will have to log on using the same ID and PASSWORD.

What you need to know to connect

Our BBS number is 203-797-6872. You will need a 2400bps or higher speed modem to access the board.

Set your communications software to:

DATA BITS=8 PARITY=N STOP BITS=1

Don't forget that Windows 3.1 comes with a communications program called "Terminal" which you can use to log on to the Grolier BBS.

Set Pause Rate

Click the Set Pause Rate button on the Button bar to set the rate at which $\underline{Random\ Records}$ are displayed. The default rate is every 5 seconds, but you can change the rate to anything between 1 and 60 seconds.
