LogConvert requires an Amiga computer with KS 2.0+ and a little free RAM.

1.4 Usage

```
The program has to be run from CLI.

LogConvert [filename] [#channel] [slideshow] [simple] [complex] [columns n]

filename: the filename of the input file
    a ".LC" suffix will be added to the output filename

#channel: which channel to convert

slideshow: the lines will be printed to stdout with small delays instead of writing them to an output file

simple: convert only messages

complex: convert everything - messages, joins, mode changes etc.

colums n: wordwrap at n colums, where n>40
```

If you leave (some of) these command line options out, the program will ask for them. The slideshow option makes an exception though.

You can break the program by pressing ctrl-c.
