TSK 2.x Users Note

The first time you open a file in The Serial Keeper 3.x it will convert the file format of 2.x to a newer format that will allow me to add features without much work. The process may take a little long depending on your file and the Mac your using. For example, If you have a big file and a 68k Mac it'll take a few minutes. Once a file is converted however, it'll load within a few seconds, even on a old 68k. Once a file is converted you can't use the converted file in 2.x. However, TSK will make a backup of the file you opened in the same folder the converted on is in. The backed up file will end in ".old"

Some features of TSK 2.x have been removed and some have changed in 3.x. One major feature is the "Other File Location" which could be used to specify a file in a different location of the drive then the TSK preferences folder. This feature has been removed because it caused problems and could be done by using an alias. To reproduce this feature, do the following:

- 1. Make an alias of the file you want to use.
- 2. Put that alias in to the TSK Preferences folder, which is located in the Preferences folder.
- 3. Name that alias "TSK Serials".

Another feature was the default file name, I've removed this because of problems with other features. You can still change the default file name for new databases though.

Registration

The Serial Keeper is now shareware, \$10 US. This started with TSK 3.0.
