PopticsThree looks somewhat as if it was drawn and decorated with a round tip marker. It contains two sets of letters and numbers to mix and match, basic symbols (\$, &, etc.), punctuation, and 52 dingbats. Good for a fun, casual look; I used it on a set of menus & table tents. The dingbats include a few holiday thingies; cats, dogs, & pigs in sunglasses, footprints, and more.

The Poptics fonts were originally only released for the Macintosh. Because of the differences in encoding, translating them to the PC presented a few problems. To make sure you have access to all of the characters, I split them into two fonts each. The first contains the basic alpha-numeric characters. The "Extras" font has the 52 dingbat characters and a few alternates.
