- Added feature to perspective. Now when you put the perspective right down to 0, the ripples have the same frequency and amplitude from top top bottom (instead of just fading out to nothing).
- Improved refresh feature when using non-mirror mode. Now whenever the background needs to be refreshed, the visible windows are temporarily hidden from sight so that they don't become a permenant part of the ripples.
- Added refresh to the tray menu. Removed it from the Options screen.
- Added rippling logo when you click on the logo.
- Added wave direction feature. Now you can make the wave go upwards. This can be useful for a picture viewing land from off-shore where the waves are moving away from the viewer etc.
- Created Advanced options section.
- Added Idle Process priority class improves refresh feature, and will help to ensure that GTRipple does not slow down other applications.
- Fixed bug in saving and restoring the window state (minimized/normal).
- Decided to make Options screen "stay on top" of other windows.

- Improved refresh feature on startup.
- Improved increment on amplitude so that you can see it moving when you click the bar.
- Added instance checking now only one instance of GTRipple can be run at the one time. If you try to run a second instance then the original instance acts as if you have clicked the tray icon.
- Added Reflect Windows option. Now you can choose whether or not the mirror mode reflects the windows. (if Mirror mode is off then Reflect $\,$ Windows does not apply).
- Added Reflect Desktop Icons option. Now you can choose whether or

not the mirror mode reflects the desktop icons (if Reflect Windows is on then Reflect Desktop Icons does not apply).

- Added sensitivity to screen resolution changes. Ripple width resizes according to screen width when screen changes are made.

- Version 1.3 Fixed flickering at startup.
- Added Start at startup option.
- Fixed bug where GTRipple would show the taskbar if it had been previously hidden by another program.
- Added increased compatibility with applications that alter the screen resolution.
- Added feature "Suspend" on popup menu. (Thanks Tony) Added "Hide Desktop Icons" option to popup menu. (Thanks Tony)
