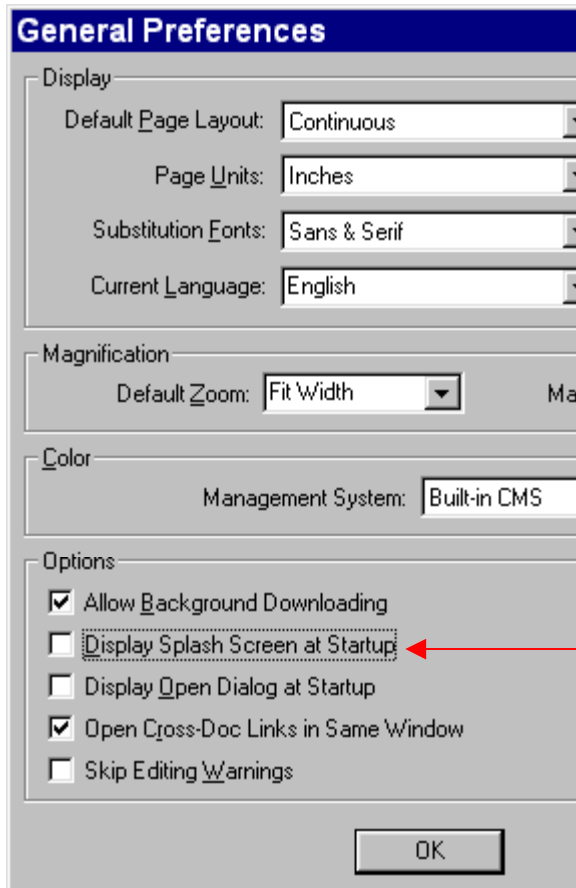


## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

**Q. How do I prevent the Acrobat Splash Screen from loading every time I open a session?**

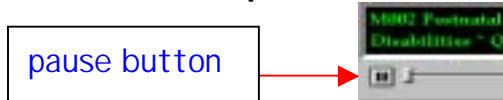
**A. Double-click the Acrobat Reader 4 icon on your desktop. Push the “Ctrl” and “K” keys on your keyboard at the same time to open the Preferences box. Deselect the box for “**



Deselect the box in front of Display Splash Screen at Start Up

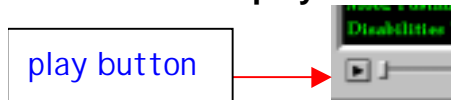
**Q. How do I pause the lecture?**

**A. Click on the pause button.**



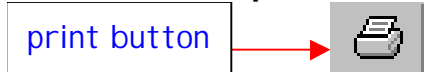
**Q. How do I play the lecture after it's paused?**

**A. Click on the play button.**



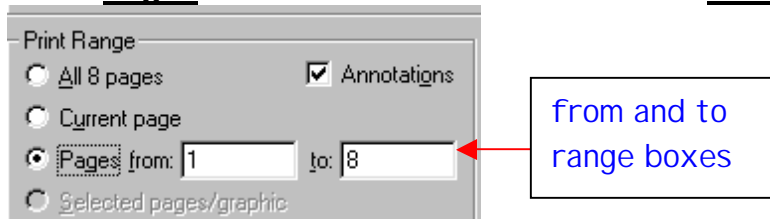
Q. How do I print the syllabus (written materials)?

A. Click on the print button at the top of the page.



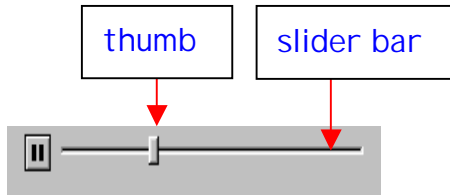
Q. How do I print only one page from the syllabus?

A. Click on the print button at the top of the page and select and enter the range on your print menu. If you want to print page 3 then click the **Pages** selection and enter 3 in both the **from** and **to** boxes.



Q. How do I fast-forward and rewind the lecture?

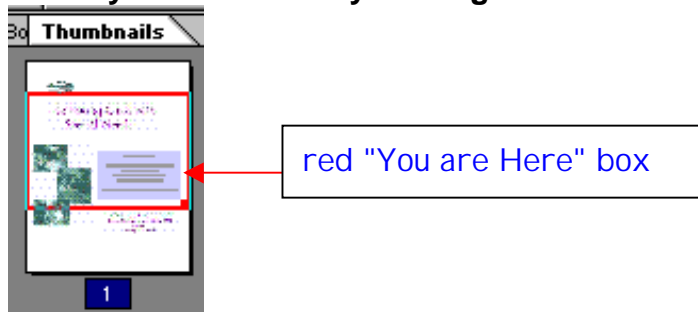
A. Click on the slider bar or click, drag and release the thumb.



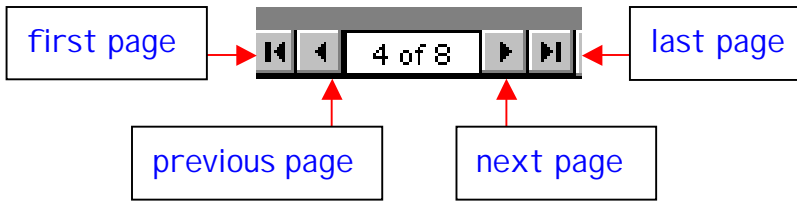
Q. How do I move through the syllabus (written materials)?

A. Use the scrollbar to the right of the page. Click on the slider bar or click, drag and release the thumb.

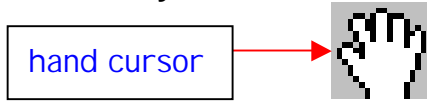
B. Double-Click on a thumbnail to the left. The red box indicates what page you are currently looking at.



C. Click on page forward or backward located on the bottom of the page.

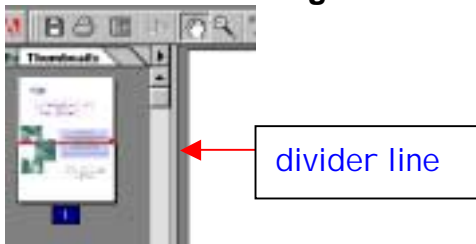


D. When your cursor looks like a hand. Click on Page and Drag.

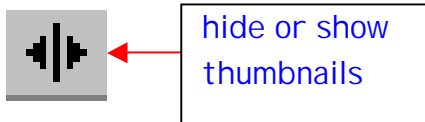


Q. How do I hide/show my thumbnails?

A. Click and drag the divider line.

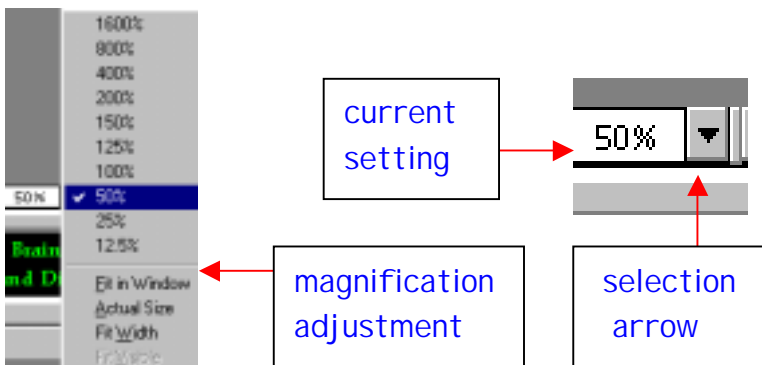


B. Click the Hide/Show button at the bottom of the page.



Q. How do I adjust the magnification?

A. Click on the arrow beside the current magnification setting and select the desired magnification.

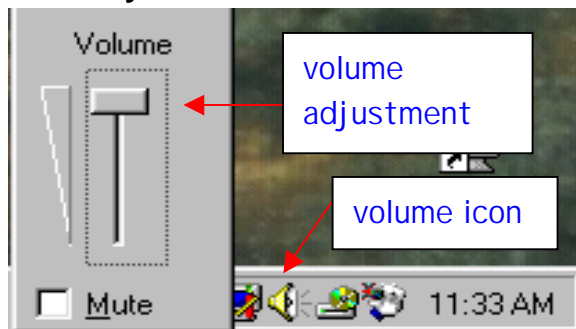


B. Click on the magnification icon at the top of the page and click on the page to increase magnification. Hold the Ctrl key down while clicking click on the page to reduce the magnification.

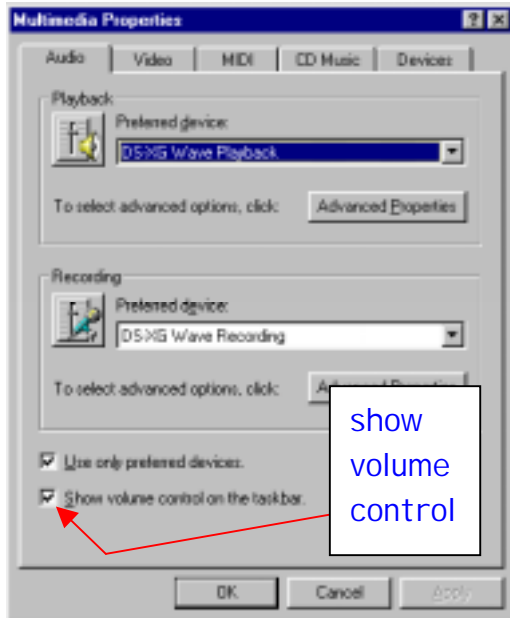


- Q. I installed Acrobat Reader 4 and when I open a session, a license agreement opens and my computer crashes?**
- A. Double-click the Acrobat Reader 4 icon on your desktop, click *Accept* on the license agreement, close Acrobat Reader, and re-start the application and run normally.**
- Q. I have Windows 95 and I can't hear any of the sessions? What's wrong?**
- A. Your system is not configured to play mp3's. Go online to Microsoft's downloads site at <http://microsoft.com/downloads> and follow the directions to download and install the upgrade for Windows Media Player.**
- Q. I put it in my audio CD-player but I couldn't hear any of the sessions**
- A. This CD cannot play in an audio CD-player. The sessions can be played in an mp3-CD-player.**

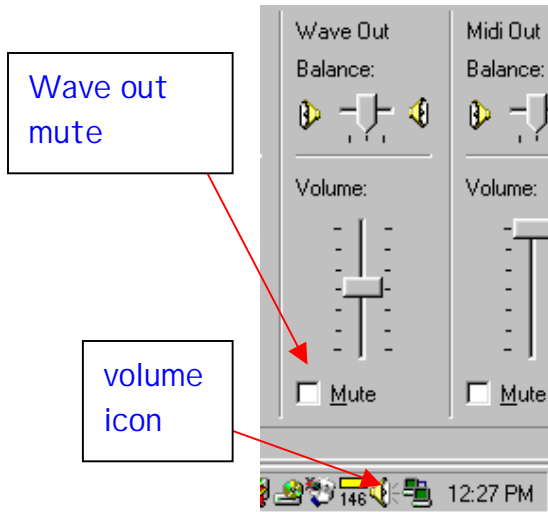
- Q. I am running the CD on a laptop and I can barely hear the sessions. How do I increase the volume?**
- A. Exit the CD. On the desktop, next to where the time is displayed in the system tray - located lower right-hand corner, look for a volume icon. Single click it and increase the volume. Re-start the application and run normally.**



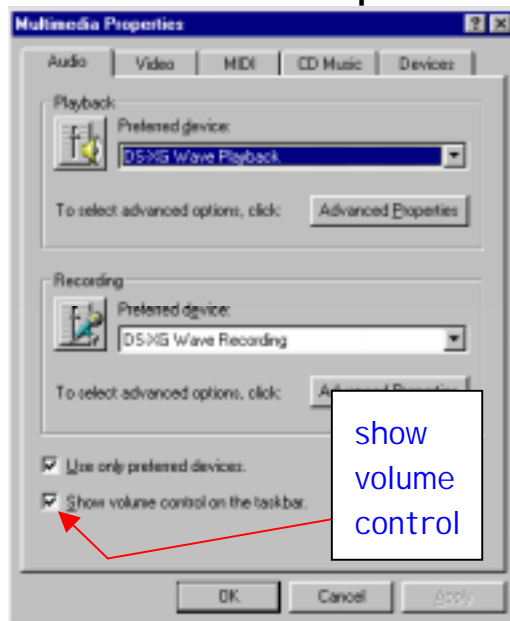
- B. If there is not a volume icon in your system tray, go to the *Start* menu in the lower left-hand corner of your desktop. Go to *Settings* and click on *Control Panel*, double-click *Multimedia*, Click on the checkbox in front of *show volume control on the taskbar*, then click *OK*. Follow directions in step A.



- Q. I cannot hear any sounds on the CD?
- A. Exit the CD. On the desktop, next to where the time is displayed in the system tray - located lower right-hand corner, look for a volume icon. Double-click it and de-select the mute checkbox on Wave Out. Re-start the application and run normally.



- B.** If there is not a volume icon in your system tray, go to the *Start* menu in the lower left-hand corner of your desktop. Go to *Settings* and click on *Control Panel*, double-click *Multimedia*, Click on the checkbox in front of *show volume control on the taskbar*, then click *OK*. Follow directions in step A.
