Run the program from within a shell. You will see entries like this:

node = $002F472C visitors = 5 screen = $002F48A8 name = Workbench
```

node - The address where the PubScreenNode was located;

visitors - The number of windows and requesters using the screen;

screen - The address of the screen itself;

name - The public name of the screen.

You can use the public name in any program that can open on a named public screen.
