### 1.2 Introduction to this PowerDOOR

-----

Introduction - What is it?

-----

Power Raw Upload is a Door that allows the Sysop to allow users to send/upload files privately to the Sysop. This is a quicker method than using a Filebase or Attaching them to messages...

What does this Door offer?

-----  
 This Door allows users to send more than one file at a time by using Z-Modem features and also by offering the User a choice to upload more files when the transfer is complete.

### 1.3 Installing PowerDOORS

-----  
 Installation of this PowerDOOR...

-----  
 All PowerDOORS are installed in the same way. Simply, make sure that there is a directory in your Doors directory or assignment called `POWER`. This is where all PowerDOORS are stored. If you do not have your DOORS directory assigned, then you should add an Assign to your Startup-Sequence or User-Startup File.

C:Assign >NIL: DOORS: BBS:Doors/

~~~~~

Change this to your Doors directory path

Now, Create a directory inside the `DOORS:Power/` Directory with the name of the Door. This is the word to the right of the `Power` in the Archive filename. So, For example, if the PowerDOOR was called PowerRAWUL, then you would create a directory in the `DOORS:Power/` directory called `RawUL`.

Now, Locate the Archive you downloaded or received. It will probably be in the `LhA` or `LZX` form. Simply use a version of `LhA` or `LZX` to Extract the files into the desired path.

C:LhA x PowerRawUL\_?.LHA DOORS:Power/RawUL/\ Where `????` is the } Name of the PowerDOOR

C:LZX x PowerRawUL\_?.LZX DOORS:Power/RawUL/ / For example, `NEWS`

Now, all the files including some File Descriptions `File\_ID.DIZ` and some Configuration files `RawUL.CFG`. Other files will also be included which are not Doors such as those that have the File Extension of `Text`. These files are ANSIs. If you find a file with an extension of `DAT`, then do not try and edit these.

## 1.4 Configuring PowerDOORS

---

### Configuration of PowerDOORS

---

All PowerDOORS are configured in the same way. In the PowerDOOR archive (or Directory if extracted), You will find file(s) with an extension of `.CFG`, These are ConFiGuration files.

Simply load these Configuration (CFG) Files into a Text Editor and either follow the simple guide located at the end of the Configuration files or use the more complex guide which is located in the Door Guide.

### Layout for the Configuration PowerRawUL

---

#### << Line 01 >> - Path & Filename

~~~~~

This line should contain the Path and Filename of an ANSI/Text File which is basically the Front-End of the main Raw Upload Door. Make sure that lines 14, 19 and 20 are all blank as these are used for Status, Information and Copyright details.

#### << Line 02 >> - Section Number

~~~~~

This line should contain the MAXsBBS File Section Number where all Sysop Files are kept. So, Enter the number of the Sysops File Section as this is where all Raw Uploads will be sent to.

#### << Line 03 >> - Optional Path

~~~~~

This line should contain a Path for where the Files are kept as many Sysops don't like to mix the Sysop files with the rest of the files, So use better FileBases such as MagicFile which allow optional paths for each file section. Make sure the Path ends in either a Colon (:) or a Forward Slash (/).

#### << Line 04 >> - End of Configuration

~~~~~

As with all PowerDOORS, The Hash (#) at the end of the Configuration signifies its end. Any text after this Hash (either to the right or below it) will be ignored by the Door making it useful to add comments about the configuration below.

---

Now, Save the Configuration File as a Plain ASCII File and not a Wordworth or other WP Document. Make sure that the File is saved in Plain ASCII otherwise it will not work.

## 1.5 Using the PowerDOOR

Using the PowerDOOR...

When the Door is loaded, The Main ANSI Screen will appear asking you to press any key to begin transfers.

After you press a key, then the message will change telling the Remote user to start Uploading files.

The MAXsBBS File Transfer window will now appear with status of the Uploads. When complete, the Door will ask the user if he/she would like to send any more files.

Either the Sysop or User can answer this. If `Y` is pressed, then the Transfer window will reappear. If anything else is pressed, the Door will exit back to the BBS.
