### 1.3 About Autodocs

Autodocs are programmer maintained documents that are embedded in the source code for an application, utility or system software. Using a special tool called Autodoc (located on DevCon disks and the Software Toolkit) these documents can be extracted from the source, indexed, alphabetized and placed in a human-readable form.

#### 1.4 About

AD2HT is fully documented in the amigaguide reference guide. It is  $\hookleftarrow$  used

to convert your autodoc-compatible doc-files into hypertext format.

Note however, that you must have your  $C_{\rm Includes}$  in a directory 'include' or any directory assigned to 'include', to let AD2HT find them. If you convert your

autodocs

without regarding this,

cross-references will not work with AUTODOC-IT!
