- 25KB Free Memory
- Kickstart 2.x or higher
- Installed Magic-User-Interface (MUI) Version 3.x
- 51200 Bytes of Stack
- Installed ARexx system

CX_NOREQ (If it set to YES no requester will inform you when commodtie Removed ect. For Arexx-Interface) DEFAULT=NO

CX\_LISTFILE (You have to specified an Path with name for the arexx command me\_getcxlst) DEFAULT=t:cxlst
