Music tracker program used: OctaMED V5.04 (OctaMED Sound Studio V1.03c~is~available for free at the RBF Software WWW site ->~http://www.octamed.co.uk~).

Jon Bat vocals have been recorded mainly at Bruno's studio~(previously~called 21 Sound Studio); later, due to errors, a couple of~phrases have been~re-recorded at Viva Radio.

Recording equipment: AKG Microphone, Sony DCT-60 DAT Deck and $Tascam \sim DA-20 \sim DAT$ Deck.

The sampling has been made with a Toccata audio board together with~the~program Samplitude MS V2.10 (which has a bug in the IFF 8SVX~saving~function; however we loaded the samples as Raw files in OctaMED).

The sad PC user drawn in the pseudo-cover has been inspired by an advertising on an old number of Commodore Computer Club... was a famous italian magazine for Commodore users (VIC-20, C-64, C-128, C-16, etc.).

1.6 System Requirements

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

Due to use of a lot of samples, this MED module (OctaMED Pro V5.0-MMD1) can be played only on Amigas with at least 2 MB of Chip RAM (ECS Agnus 8375 or AGA) or on machines with 2 MB of RAM at least, if you use a player that loads samples in Fast RAM (eg. DeliTracker).

Note: if you have a bare 2 MB Amiga, you may encounter some loading problems due to memory limitations.

If you find these ones please try to reduce the amount of memory used by deactivating background programs (like commodities) and by reducing your Workbench colors and resolution.

If you still have problems do the following:

- 1. disable booting with Startup-Sequence by selecting the relative option in the bootup menu (press both mouse buttons after a reset for Amiga OS 2.0 and above) or by pressing $\langle CTRL-D \rangle$ to stop execution (Amiga OS 1.X).
- 2. Once in the CLI type the complete path of the player followed by the complete path of the module, and than press <RETURN>.
 - e.g. DH0:Tools/OctaMEDPlayer DH0:Modules/PC_Hurts.med
- 3. Pump up the volume and enjoy! \;^)
