Installation is easy and painless! Just copy DLManager.thor to your [VOLUME]:Thor/rexx directory and run it!

When you run DLManager a window will appear with eight (08) buttons.

Those buttons are:

- 1) Get System
- 2) New/Add List
- 3) WriteMesg
- 4) DelList
- 5) Quit

- 6) Edit DisList
- 7) About
- 8) Delete User (single)

They perform the following functions (in order of appearance):

1. Get System - gets the system you want to send the email from.
Also used for getting email address from the User Database.
2. New/Add List - Creates a list or adds to an existing list.
can add the address manually or from the User Database.
3. WriteMesg - Get Ready to write your message! This also adds the message as an event. Uses your configured editor.
4. DelList - Deletes the list you select (use Caution!)
5. Quit - Ends the program.
6. Edit DisList - Edits a list you select. If you don't want to use Nr. 2 above use this to add/delete the email addresses.
Used mostly for deleting multiple email addresses.
7. About - About
8. Delete User - Deletes a user from a .tdl file. It only deletes one user at a time - even though you select many

v1.1 - First Release! - (12.04.97)

v1.2 - Second Release! - (12.06.97)

Fixed a bug that caused DLManager to crash when adding addresses to a new distribution list.

Fixed a second bug that cropped up when I fixed the first bug! The Delete command (button) didn't work until you selected New/Add or Edit. Sheesh!

v1.3 - Third Release! - (12.07.97)

This is really an "upgrade" I guess. I added a function that will allow your .sig file to be added to your outgoing messages.

v1.4 - Fourth Release! - (12.26.97)

Rewrote the Add user function. The users are now on their own lines and if you have more than 250 characters in the file, DLManager will break it up and add Cc: headers. This routine was shamelessly stripped from BulkMail! Suitably

changed of course to make it work for DLManager!

v1.5 - Fifth Release! - (03JAN98)

Rewrote the write message function and added a WriteCC() function. You can now have as many users in a .tdl file as you want.

DLManager will search the .tdl file until it reaches > 250 characters, when it does it adds a new line and appends a 'Cc:' to the header of your outgoing message and adds the rest of the addresses there.

v1.7 - Seventh Release - (31MAR98) (really sixth)

Added a function that will add the sig files and change the \$ver and \$time keywords that Thor uses. This is an update I guess you could say to v1.3
