#### 1.2 Notes about ratings

Notes about ratings

No one will agree with my ratings I'm sure. But hey, I \*had\* to make them, I could not just throw hundreds to thousands of mods at you. I've tried to be neutral: I made a separate ranking for each mod style, using the full range of marks, even if I didn't like the style.

A module needs two properties to get a top rating from me: Good samples and a melody that doesn't go on one's nerves within 30 seconds. Because of that, and because each style has its own top mods, you'll find many non techno mods in the top ratings.
