Following the previous pre-release of Tandem on Aminet, this is release 1 of Tandem, Version 2.68, released April 2000.

Tandem is freeware - see copyright notice in Tandem.guide
 Not to be distributed in a commercial product without permission

Tandem requires at least 1Meg to run, and AmigaOS 2.04+

To Run Tandem, click the Tandem.exe icon.

To Install Tandem, just drag and drop the Tandem drawer icon.

The Tandem drawer must contain the following files:

If you save prefs from within Tandem, ENVARC:tandem.prefs will exist.

You can do the following (optional) CLI commands if you want to:

```
copy tandem/tandem.library to LIBS:tandem.library
delete tandem/tandem.library
```

You must have the Amiga Developer CD (published by Schatzruhe) to use Tandem, and preferably the 2.04 RKM's, published by Addison Wesley.

Improvements on Release 1

The previous pre-release of Tandem proved very stable and robust. Only 1 important bug was found, which on some configurations of Amiga caused Tandem to refuse to assemble in rare instances. This has been fixed.

I have also made the following improvements:

1. Tandem now opens on the default public screen. You can still cause it to use its own screen by Clicking "Prefs" and setting preferences appropriately.
2. Tandem now remembers the position and size of its windows, and restores them to those sizes and positions (if possible) next time you run it.
3. The <Tab> key now operates in the normal Amiga fashion, and will jump to tab positions in multiples of 8, in Tandem's text editor.
4. The icon for the Demo program has been fixed to run ok with OS3.5 (as well as OS2.04+).
5. An additional parameter for TLreqshow to show a line initially highlighted.
6. Tldemo has been re-written.
