### 1.2 The introduction...

When I download files from Aminet, I save them in my "Aminet:" directory, with the same tree-structure as the original Aminet archive. I don't download the "\*.readme" files, so after few days it's a little problem to know what's in the archives. I thought, I could comment these archives with "short" information, which is displayed on the right side when browsing through the Aminet website. Yeah, good idea, but it's boring to search the informations, and write them by hand - especially if you're downloading many archives. So, I wrote this script. All you need is load the Aminet index, select the achive, and the script will do the rest. Simple, but I think that it's helpful.

### 1.3 Should I have the PowerPC?

This is a ARexx script, so you should have REXXMAST running in your system. Then, you'll need CygnusEd (I've tested my script with Ced v4.2), and the Aminet Index File (download it from one of the Aminet FTP Mirrors). That's all! Oh, almost forgot, you must change Ced's current directory to dir with your archives (use the Project Menu option to do this). I will change it in "future" version, if I have to.

You also should have the "FileNote" command in "C:" directory.

### 1.4 How to install it?

Installation is very simple. All you have to do, is put this script to your dir with Ced ARexx scripts (I have it in "REXX:CED" directory). Then you can install it in Ced, using "Special/DOS-ARexx Interface/Install Command" menu. Then, load the Aminet Index File, change Ced's current dir to your archive directory, and run the script.

### 1.5 How can I use it?

After succesfull :) installation, load the Aminet Index File, change Ced's current dir to your archive directory, and run the script - if you've installed it in Ced's menu, choose it. Then, choose your archive with file requester. Script will search it in the Index. If it will be found, script will ask you if it's the file you've selected (because sometimes different files, has the same archive name). If your answer will be "OK", file will be commented. Other case, script will search for another position with this name, and if there is no another file, script will end. That's all. If you have more archives, you must repeat this action for every file. Maybe I'll change it in "future" versions? Who knows.
