of the language. It is designed  
to \*support\* classroom work, not to replace it.

## 1.4 Verbes.guide/Important information

Subjects

- \* Nous and vous are always considered plural.
- \* In the passé composé, all uses of je, tu, nous and vous are considered masculine.

Generic use of these pronouns will help in avoiding errors when the subject of the pronoun is unknown. There are also many examples with the subjects elle, ils and elles so that the agreement of past participles may be practised.

Note that the participe présent is not strictly a tense, but it is a very common conjugation form.

## 1.18 Verbes.guide/New

'Project/New' clears the current verb and tense selections, resets the number of questions to zero, and clears the student's name. This is generally used when a different student begins to use the program.

If the current selections have not been saved, a requester will appear, verifying the operation.

---

## 1.19 Verbes.guide/Open...

'Project/Open...' replaces the current verb and tense selections, number of questions and student name with the settings previously saved via

Project/Save

or

Project/Save As...

. A standard file requester will open, allowing the student to choose any file available.

If the current selections have not been saved, a requester will appear, verifying the operation.

## 1.20 Verbes.guide/Save

'Project/Save' and the 'Save' gadget save the current settings (verb

and tense selections, number of questions and student name) in the file that is currently in use. If a filename has not been previously given, a file requester will open (see

Project/Save As...

). The file may be

opened for use later using the

Project/Open...

menu item.

## 1.21 Verbes.guide/Save As...

'Project/Save As...' saves the current settings under a (possibly

new) name. A standard file requester will open, allowing the student to type in or select a filename. The file may be opened for use later using the

Project/Open...

menu item.

## 1.22 Verbes.guide/About...

'Project/About...' opens a window containing program and version information. When reporting bugs or commenting on the program, please include the information found here.



## 1.23 Verbes.guide/Quit

'Project/Quit' and the 'Cancel' gadget quit Ensemble Verbes. If the current selections have not been saved, a requester will appear, verifying the operation.

## 1.24 Verbes.guide/Create\_Icons

When checked, 'Settings/Create Icons' tells Ensemble Verbes to   
 save   
 icons with its data files; when unchecked, it will not.

If 'Settings/Create Icons' is unchecked and   
 Settings/Save Settings   
 is selected, the   
 NOICONS   
 tooltype will be added to the Ensemble Verbes   
 icon.

## 1.25 Verbes.guide/FixedSize

If 'Settings/Fixed String Size' is unchecked, Ensemble Verbes   
 will   
 provide a subtle hint to the correct answer by making the gadget used   
 to enter verb forms the \*exact\* size that it needs to be for the   
 correct answer. When it is checked, a fixed-size gadget will be used   
 no matter what the length of the correct answer.

If 'Settings/Fixed String Size' is checked and   
   
 Settings/Save Settings   
 is selected, the   
 FIXESIZE   
 tooltype will be   
 added to the Ensemble Verbes icon.

Ensemble Verbes icon. This makes them the initial settings.

## 1.28 Verbes.guide/Correct...

'Settings/Sounds/Correct...' lets the student select a sound to play

when he/she enters a correct answer.

The

CORRECTSOUND

tooltype will be added to all saved icons if a sound is used. The sound may be made the default by selecting

Settings/Save Settings

.

## 1.29 Verbes.guide/Incorrect...

'Settings/Sounds/Inorrect...' lets the student select a sound to play

when he/she enters an incorrect answer.

The

INCORRECTSOUND

tooltype will be added to all saved icons if a sound is used. The sound may be made the default by selecting

Settings/Save Settings  
.

### 1.30 Verbes.guide/Verb\_Gadgets

These gadgets allow a student to select -er, -ir, -re, reflexive or irregular verbs from a list. The cycle gadgets will let the student easily select every verb in a particular list ('All') or remove all currently-selected verbs that belong to that list ('None'). (They will display 'Selected' when some of the verbs in a list are chosen.) The last gadget allows the student to see all of the selected verbs; any that are not wanted may be removed by selecting them individually.

### 1.31 Verbes.guide/Tense\_Gadgets

These gadgets allow the student to select any combination of Ensemble Verbes' seven tenses  
.

### 1.32 Verbes.guide/Name

This gadget is used for the student's name. It will be used in congratulatory messages; it will also appear at the beginning of any saved or printed test files.

### 1.33 Verbes.guide/Num\_questions

These gadgets allow the student to select the number of questions for a practice or test.

### 1.34 Verbes.guide/Review

Review current list of verbs in currently-selected tenses.

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### **1.35 Verbes.guide/Practice**

Practice using current verb list and selected tenses.

### **1.36 Verbes.guide/Test**

Test using current verb list and selected tenses.

### **1.37 Verbes.guide/Verb\_String**

This gadget has a box in which the student enters an answer for the current question. It also allows the student to get help during a practice, simply by pressing the Help key.

### **1.38 Verbes.guide/Select\_Accent**

These gadgets allow the student to insert an accent into the answer gadget at the current cursor position. They may also show the keystrokes required to type the indicated accent.

### **1.39 Verbes.guide/Next\_Question**

Press this button to go to the next question.

### **1.40 Verbes.guide/Quit\_Test**

Press this button at any time to quit the current practice or test. Your mark will be based on the number of questions completed.

### Icon ToolTypes

Most ToolTypes may be set directly through the Workbench's 'Icon/Information...' menu or from inside the program. Currently, 'PUBSCREEN' must be set from the Workbench; only in a special case (noted below) can it be set from Ensemble Verbes.

'CORRECTSOUND='<path to IFF sound file>''

'CORRECTSOUND' specifies the full path to a sound to use for a correct answer. It may be set inside the program by selecting the

Settings/Sounds/Correct...  
menu item.

'FIXEDSIZE'

If 'FIXEDSIZE' is specified, Ensemble Verbes will fix the size of the

answer gadget

. By default, Ensemble Verbes changes the gadget width to give a subtle hint to the answer. It may be set inside the program by selecting the

Settings/Fixed String Size?  
menu item.

'FONTNAME='<font name>.font''

An alternate font name may be specified with this tooltype. The name must include the '.font' suffix. The 'FONTSIZE' tooltype must also be specified; otherwise it has no effect.

'FONTSIZE='<font size>''

This tooltype allows the selection of a particular font size when the 'FONTNAME' is specified. Otherwise it has no effect.

'INCORRECTSOUND='<path to IFF sound file>''

'INCORRECTSOUND' specifies the full path to a sound to use for an incorrect answer. It may be set inside the program by selecting the

Settings/Sounds/Incorrect...  
menu item.

'KEYMAP='<path to keymap file>''

This ToolType takes a complete path to an alternate keymap file, e.g. 'DEVS:keymaps/cdn' or 'KEYMAPS:usa2'. The keymap is \*not\* used for menu shortcuts.

'LANGUAGE='<language>''

'LANGUAGE' specifies the language to be used for all text in the program. The name of the language should be given in that language; for example, French would be given as 'français'.

'NOICONS'

If 'NOICONS' is specified, Ensemble Verbes will not save icons with verb files. By default, Ensemble Verbes saves icons. May be set

inside the program by selecting the  
Settings/Create Icons?  
menu  
item.

`'PUBSCREEN=<public screen name>'`

`'PUBSCREEN'` specifies the public screen on which Ensemble Verbes will attempt to open. If not specified, Ensemble Verbes will attempt to open on the default public screen (usually Workbench), then on a public screen named `'VERBES.1'`. If specified, Ensemble Verbes will attempt to open on the named public screen, creating it if necessary; if unable to open there, Ensemble Verbes will default to `'VERBES.1'`.

If Ensemble Verbes is forced to open on a public screen, the name of this screen will be saved whenever  
Settings/Save Settings  
is  
chosen.

`'CORRECTSOUND'`

`'CORRECTSOUND'` specifies the full path to a sound to use for a correct answer. It may be set inside the program by selecting the

Settings/Sounds/Correct...  
menu item.

`'FIXEDSIZE'`

If `'FIXEDSIZE'` is specified, Ensemble Verbes will fix the size of the

answer gadget

. By default, Ensemble Verbes changes the gadget width to give a subtle hint to the answer. It may be set inside the program by selecting the

Settings/Fixed String Size?  
menu item.

`'FONTNAME'`

An alternate font name may be specified with this parameter. The name must include the `'.font'` suffix. The `'FONTSIZE'` parameter must also be specified; otherwise it has no effect.

`'FONTSIZE'`

This parameter allows the selection of a particular font size when

the 'FONTNAME' is specified. Otherwise it has no effect.

#### 'FROM'

The file specified will be used as the initial settings for Ensemble Verbes.

#### 'INCORRECTSOUND'

'INCORRECTSOUND' specifies the full path to a sound to use for a correct answer. It may be set inside the program by selecting the

Settings/Sounds/Correct...  
menu item.

#### 'KEYMAP'

This parameter takes a complete path to an alternate keymap file, e.g. 'DEVS:keymaps/cdn' or 'KEYMAPS:usa2'. The keymap is \*not\* used for menu shortcuts.

#### 'LANGUAGE'

'LANGUAGE' specifies the language to be used for all text in the program. The name of the language should be given in that language; for example, French would be given as 'français'.

#### 'NOICONS'

If 'NOICONS' is specified, Ensemble Verbes will not save icons with verb files. By default, Ensemble Verbes saves icons. May be set inside the program by selecting the

Settings/Create Icons?  
menu item.

#### 'PUBSCREEN'

'PUBSCREEN' specifies the public screen on which Ensemble Verbes will attempt to open. If not specified, Ensemble Verbes will attempt to open on the default public screen (usually Workbench), then on a public screen named 'VERBES.1'. If specified, Ensemble Verbes will attempt to open on the named public screen, creating it if necessary; if unable to open there, Ensemble Verbes will default to 'VERBES.1'.

If Ensemble Verbes is forced to open on a public screen, the name of this screen will be saved whenever

Settings/Save Settings  
is

chosen.

## 1.43 Verbes.guide/Common Problems

### Common Problems

\*\*\*\*\*

\*The accented characters don't show up, or appear as boxes.\*  
Your chosen font does not have a definition for the accented characters. Choose another that does. If you do not want to

change your system settings, use the  
FONTNAME  
and  
FONTSIZE  
ToolTypes to select a font for Ensemble Verbes to use.

\*Ensemble Verbes doesn't use the font I specified.\*

Make sure that you have the font name spelled out exactly, in exact case, and that you have included the '.font' suffix. Verify that you have specified both

FONTNAME  
and  
FONTSIZE

.

\*Ensemble Verbes doesn't open on the default public screen.\*

Ensure that you have not specified a  
PUBSCREEN  
parameter.

If you have specified

FONTNAME  
and  
FONTSIZE

, be sure that the font will fit on the screen. Try reducing  
FONTSIZE

.

\*Gadgets do not adapt correctly to my default font.\*

There is a problem with some fonts that are incorrectly defined; hence, Ensemble Verbes has no way to determine the correct sizes.

You must use the

FONTNAME  
and  
FONTSIZE

ToolTypes to specify an alternate font.

\*Menu and gadget text is not in the language I wanted.\*

You should have the ToolType

LANGUAGE

to the language you want, in that language. For example, French may be selected by specifying 'LANGUAGE=français'.

Be sure that 'Verbes.catalog' is present in either 'Catalogs/<language>' or 'LOCALE:Catalogs/<language>'. The 'Install\_Verbes' script may be used to install additional languages automatically.
