1.1 Keyboard Shortcuts

MENU COMMANDS

Keyboard shortcuts for menu commands are shown in the menus. Most menu shortcuts use the Right Amiga key, which is represented by the A symbol in the menu. To use one of these shortcuts, hold down the Right Amiga key and press the character shown in the menu.

Type menu commands followed by a caret ^ symbol and then a character can be executed by pressing the character while holding down the Ctrl key. Object menu commands followed by a single character can be executed by pressing the character without holding down a qualifier key. (If the Object menu shortcut is uppercase, Shift must be held down.)

Only Right Amiga keyboard equivalents can be shown in the menus with AmigaDOS $2.0\ 2.1$. The Type and Object menu keyboard equivalents will not be visible although they will still function.

OBJECT EDITING SHORTCUTS

Nudging objects: Object(s) must be selected with the Object or Reshape tool to nudge them.

Nudge objects Shortcut
Nudge left Left Arrow
Nudget right Right Arrow
Nudge up Up Arrow
Nudge down Down Arrow

* hold down a Shift key to move by 10% of the nudge amount

Move and scale contents of a frame: A picture, drawing, EPS object, compound object, or group must be selected with the Reshape tool to shift or scale the contents within its frame.

Shift contents of frame

Ctrl Up Arrow

Center contents in frame

Path point editing: You can edit the points in a path with the keyboard when at least one point in a path is selected with the Reshape tool.

Select and delete points Shortcut
Select next point Alt Up Arrow
Select previous point Alt Down Arrow

Nudget right Right Arrow
Nudge up Up Arrow

TEXT EDITING SHORTCUTS

Moving the insertion point: You can move the insertion point when it has been placed into a text object with the Text tool by using the keyboard.

Text selection and deletion: To select text with the keyboard, you must start a block at the insertion point, move the insertion point with the arrow keys (see above), and end the block.

Kerning, tracking and leading: When a block of text is selected, using the kerning and tracking shortcuts will set the tracking. When the insertion point is between two characters, these shortcuts will manually kern the characters.

The leading shortcuts change the leading in different amounts, depending on whether relative or fixed leading is selected.

Breaks and indents: You can specify where text should be broken into paragraphs and columns with break and indent controls. The insertion point must be placed in a text object to insert these.
