Just enter the Acronym in the text entry Bar, and the Database will be searched for any entries. All found entries will then be listed in the window.

Use only standard letters for example from the German Dfü you should enter Dfue. You can ignore Upper and lowercase letters as the program treats them all as the same. You should not use any connecting strokes such as CD-Rom just use CDROM. The same applies to fullstops & Spaces. This has been done to simplify the usage.

That's it really not much more to say. It could not be easier.
