## 1.2 A few introductory words:

Introduction to A-Start (preview version):

Before I start telling you about A-Start, I would like to remind you that this is only a preview version, with which you will only get a limited feel for what A-Start can do. Many of A-Start's features are not present yet.

A-Start is a multi-function utility. It is a handy alternative to tool managers and program launchers, but that is not all. Its GUI gives you an easy and intuitive way to control and keep track of some of the most important and often used functions of your system. For example editing your preferences or like launching your favorite programs are now just a few clicks away. You'll have fast access to your projects, whether it is programming, graphics, or sound: two clicks, and you are in your programming-environment, paint program, or music editor editing your project.

Using A-Start, you can browse through your partitions in no time, and do whatever you need to do with the files encountered. A-Start recognizes the file types for you, and will start your preferred viewer or player. All with beautiful graphics and relaxing sound. But wait, there's more! Delete, move, or rename files is a snap with A-Start!

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## 1.3 System Requirements

What you need in order to run A-Start:

Kickstart 2.04:

This version of Kickstart nowadays is standard, so get yourself OS3.1 if you are running an amiga under 2.04!

MagicWB:

To make A-Start look its best, you need MagicWB colors. MagicWB-colors are also being supported by AT:s new 'Walker'-machine, and should be standard.

Screen mode:

It is recommended that you use a screen mode with a 1:1 screen pixel aspect & a large page-size (min. 640\*400).

Hard disk:

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A-Start is not very useful without a hard disk, and with today's hardware prices, every Amiga user should have one! HD's are to be thought of as standard equipment.

Font:

You need the XHelvetica font, which comes with the Magic-WB package.

WBStart-Handler

:

A-Start does not necessarily need it, but without it you are not able to use some functions of A-Start

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## 1.4 What can A-Start do for you?

A-Start features:

- Easy to use: pop-up windows and intuitive gadgets
- Graphically pleasing look-and-feel
- Easy control of your preferences
- Easy access to your most used programs
- Easy access to projects you are working on
- Fast file-browser always within reach
- Automatic recognition of file types

Please remember that this describes what the A-Start preview can do: the full version will have many more features. Please see the future page for more information.

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## 1.5 install

How to install A-Start:

To install this software, double-click on the install icon and the installer will guide you through the installation.

To enable running of A-Start on every BootUp after the initial installation, copy the A-StartWBS program to your WBStartup directory. Please make sure that the A-Start path is typed in correctly in the only tooltype of A-StartWBS.info.

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## 1.6 usage

How to run A-Start:

Two programs are included in this package: the A-Start main program, and the small A-StartWBS program. Because the main program has to reside in its own directory with specific subdirectories it cannot be placed directly in your `sys:wbstartup/` directory. If you want A-Start to start every time you boot your system, you may put the A-StartWBS program into `sys:wbstartup/`. (it will run A-Start from the directory specified in its only tooltype. Make sure this tooltype is properly set to be the A-Start home directory)

For example: `APATH=dhl:utils/A-Start/`

How to use the

PREVIEW  
version of A-Start

First of all you have to start the program by double-clicking on its icon, or by running it from the CLI. A small button should appear at the bottom left of your workbench screen (note that if your workbench screen is not open, A-Start will open it). Click on that button, and the main window pops up, presenting you with seven different selections (selected by moving the cursor over it):

MyComputer  
Browse through your mounted drives.

UserProgs  
Start your most often used programs.

FileList  
Start your most important projects

Utilities  
Start a system utility program(n/a).

Preferences  
Quicklink to your preferences directory

Command  
Issue a CLI command

Reboot (quit)  
Quit A-Start/Reboot your Amiga (TM)

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## 1.7 mycomp

MyComputer:

After pressing this button, a window pops up showing all your mounted disk devices by name. Selecting one of the disk gadgets brings the root directory of that disk to front.

You may to your liking create hotlinks to directories and display them in this window. If you for example have a directory full of pictures and often take a glance at them you may find it easier to create a hotlink in order to get to that directory rather than to browse through subdirectories after subdirectories. To create a hotlink just drag and drop the corresponding ICON onto this window and the hotlink will be created.

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## 1.8 Define your most used programs

UserProgs:

This gadget brings your progs-window to front. This is a window where all your favorite programs reside. Drag the icon for the program you wish to have fast access to, and drop it into this window: it will be redrawn, now containing your program.

It is not possible to drop drives or directories into the window, but in future versions it will be possible to organize your programs even better, through "program independent" drawers: there will be an option to put related programs into specific directories, created with the A-StartPrefs program.

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## 1.9 A button to launch your projects fast

FileList:

This works like the UserProgs window, but in here you should only put projects you are currently working on. A-Start will check the default tool for the selected project, and load the default program. This allows for a rapid return to editing your source code again, after

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for example your last test run crashed your system.

## 1.10 This is not implemented yet!

Utilities:

In this version of A-Start, this window does nothing.

In a future version this is where you can place any program you wish to have quick and easy access to.

## 1.11 prefs

Preferences:

This is a quicklink to `sys:prefs/` for quick and easy (am I repeating myself?) access to all the preferences programs of your Amiga(TM).

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## 1.12 command

Command:

After depressing this button, a requester pops open where you may enter a CLI command, and A-Start will execute it. This is like pressing `rCommand e` on newer OS-versions.

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## 1.13 reboot

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Reboot:

You may shut down A-Start by clicking on this gadget and holding the left mousebutton for one second pressed. After releasing, A-Start will terminate.

To SoftBoot your machine simply double-click onto this gadget.

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## 1.14 programmers

As you may have noticed, there is a button named "Utilities" on the main window of A-Start. It points to a directory in the program dir called Utils. Currently, this drawer is empty and when you press this button you get a "Directory not found" message. This is where YOU can help:

The Utilities button was created to organize a number of system tools to help the you communicate with the OS. The idea is to predefine these tools and integrate them with A-Start, so they are always present. These programs would help the user control the Amiga OS and its most important functions. They would have their own small id-icons, and would be provided and updated with every new version of A-Start. The problem is that neither I, nor any other member of voidParrot Software has the time to design and code these programs... So I ask you to help us.

Programs like the following would most certainly be integrated into A-start and published with it:

- Commodity exchange tool
- File finder
- Calculator
- ...

All these programs should be intuitive and graphically enhanced. Interested programmers should email me, to receive a detailed description of what to do. We can also provide programmers with graphics, sound, music, and tips.

At the time there are programmers working on:

- Clock tool
- CPU info

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## 1.16 This is a preview!

A-Start is currently being developed, and V1.0 will be released in 'near' future. To see how you can support me, and how to get me to release the next version more quickly, see the Register page.

## 1.17 The Prefs program

Preferences:

To configure A-Start to your own liking, start the prefs program (located in your sys:prefs/ drawer after successful installation). The preference program requires MUI 2.2+.

In the main prefs window you will see three different pages:

Cache:

Store file type in file comments:

A-Start tries to save the file's type in its file comment, so the second time (even after rebooting) the filetype check will work much faster. For this, A-Start needs six bytes at the end of the comment string. If the file comment is so large that it covers the last six bytes, type caching is not done (because the last six characters of the comment could be destroyed). If you don't care if your file comments are clobbered, you can enable the option to always save the file type in the file comment.

This may improve type checking speed, depending on the size of your file comments.

Use WBStarter whenever possible:

When this checkmark is set, A-Start will check if your files have corresponding .info files, and if so, they are started with Stefan Beckers

WBStarter-handler

. Otherwise

a normal CLI run command will be issued (with or without icons).

FileWindow:

Maximum Y-entries:

Here you enter the maximum number of entries that will be shown in a file window. If the number of files exceeds this number,

"slide pointers" will appear on top and bottom of the window.

#### Y-Slides:

Here you enter the number of entries wich will be scrolled when you depress one of the slide pointers.

#### Maximum X-size:

Here you define the maximum X-Size of the FileWindows. FileNames, which exceed this length will be shortened and will be marked with three dots at the end. ('...')

#### Viewers:

Here you enter the paths for viewers to show text files, IFF, GIF, and JPEG pictures, and AmigaGuide files. The viewers must support arguments.

#### Players:

Same as Viewers, except you define here the Music- and Sound-players.

#### Misc:

#### Gadget-look:

Here you may define the look of the Gadgets out of three possibilities.

#### No GFX:

When this checkmark is set, the mainwindow will be displayed without the border-gfx. Some may like it better that way.

#### MainWindow-Placing:

With the popup-menu and the slider you can define the place of the A-Start-window. Press the Test-button to see where the window is beeing placed.

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## 1.18 Stefan Beckers WBStart-handler

### About WBStarter:

WBStart-handler is a handler copyrighted and written by Stefan Becker.

### Short Description:

WBStart is a handler wich lets you run programs in "WB-mode"

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from CLI. The program now thinks it has been started from the workbench, by double-clicking on its icon.

A-Start does not NEED WBStart-handler, but without it you will not be able to use the 'WBStarter' option in the prefs program, nor the FileList-window. Most of you have it in your L: directory, but should it be otherwise, please get the WBStarter package from Aminet. A-Start does not use the WBStarter library, because it needs OS3.0 to function.

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## 1.19 Magic User Interface

About Magic User Interface:

MUI is shareware, copyrighted by Stefan Stunz. You do not have to register MUI in order to use the A-Start preferences program, but I really think you should, because of the superb quality of the MUI system.

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## 1.21 Register and support shareware

How to "register" and why?

At this stage of development, this software is considered to be FreeWare. This means that anyone may use it without any restrictions.

So why "register"?

By registering you first of all give me feed-back that A-Start is a useful program, thus inspiring me to finish the 1.0 version more quickly. The 1.0 version of A-Start will be released as shareware.

The fact is that I will continue developing A-Start no matter how many users register or send me comments. I think it is a useful piece of software, and that it should be developed further into new dimensions. And why not support a programmer who's software you use? I haven't slept for many weeks to give you the pleasure of using this program, now its you're time to do something for me ;).

Why do I write "register" in quotation marks?

At this stage you cannot 'register', due to the freeware status of the program. You can only support me. BUT: All users who support me at this stage will be treated as registered users of future A-Start releases.

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## 1.22 What is to come?

Future versions of A-Start:

A-Start is right now going through serious development and many things WILL change and be included in future versions:

- It will be possible to enter "drawers" into the proglis and file-list-windows. This will give you another way to organize your files and projects (for example, put all gfx programs into a proglis/gfx directory, and all text editors into proglis/text).
- The command window is UGLY. This will change in future versions.
- Many more file-types will be supported. If you have a file type that you want included, please e-mail me!
- Not only a lot of neat graphics will be added, but also music and sound-effects. Of course with full ability to customize.

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## 1.23 New features of A-Start

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early April 96 - A-Start v0.87 released  
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New features and improvements:

-I have decided not to send KeyFiles to the registered users, because many do not have e-mail. I have decided that A-Start will ask the user for their name and a specific code. All registered users will be send this code, so that they can use A-Start without any restrictions.

-If you want to reboot you now have to double-click on the 'Reboot'-gadget. If you want to quit A-Start hold down the 'Reboot'-gadget for one second.

-You have to change your prefs-settings concerning the programs to start when a specific file-type is being selected. Now you must enter something like this:

```
Sys:Utils/Multiview {f}
```

you may also add parameters for the programs as for example:

```
C:ShowGif {f} -aga -fullscreen
```

or

```
C:ShowMeAJpeg -24Bit -SuperDuper {f}
```

The '{f}' will be replaced by the complete path and name of the selected file. This must be present, because otherwise A-Start cannot know, where the name should be stated.

-A-Start's stability has been increased very much. Many Enforcer-hits have been corrected.

-The 'START-gadget' may now be placed wherever you like. An option has been added to enable the user to define, whether the main-window should be opened up- or downwards. It is now also possible to make A-Start open its sub-menus from right to left instead of from left to right. All this can be set up in the prefs-editor.

-By pressing the right mouse-button, when a filewindow with sliders is open A-Start will increase the size of the window to fit the whole screen.

-You now may add hotlinks to directories in the MyComputer-window. Just drag a directory-icon onto this window to add the hotlink. A new entry then appears just like in the proglis and filelist-windows which enables you to open that drawer with only two clicks. You could for example drop your pics-drawer onto the MyComputer-window and so have fast access to your pics.

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-Some minor improvements to the Prefs-editor.

-CPU-usage has been reduced dramatically.

-It is now possible to leave out the graphics of the main-window.

-Subdirectories in Proglis didn't make it to this version, sorry. Neither did the recognition of other file-types. Send me comments for/against A-Start using WhatIs.library!

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March 96 - A-Start v0.72 ready  
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New features:

-A-StartWBS-program added to the package. With it you can start A-Start on every bootup from your WBStartup-drawer.

-THE FILELIST-WINDOW IS NOW IN USE! Read the usage-section to find out, how and why to use it...

-Possibility to choose the look of the gadget, appearing below the mouse-pointer. Use A-Start prefs to configure it.

-A-StartPrefs rewritten. The v0.72 A-StartPrefs-program does NOT support the v0.52 Env-file, but all newer versions of A-Start will be backward-compatible.

-Possibility to define your prefs-drawer in case you do not put your pref-files into 'Sys:Prefs/'.

-You may now choose if A-Start closes its windows after viewing a pic, reading a text..., or if the windows should remain opened.

-Support for Mod and Med- MusicDataFiles and Sound-effects.

-Bugfixing. A-Start SHOULD work now better on 3.1 platforms.
