early years, movie production was on 8mm film with no sound. At that time,
the company went under the name of Leadstar Newt productions. The best of
the LN films was the hilarious (in retrospect) copy of
Star Wars
that
contains the famous three pass kissing scene and the 'Chewie wants a banana'
segment.

Among the video titles are the Sheridan family series, The Texas Instruments,
The Rhinos - Live! and Conestoga Homegrown.

Star Wars

Shot in silent 8mm format, this is one of the wierdest films that FBN has
been involved in to date. Watch for the spinning christmas lights of the
hyperspace segment and the funky tartan blanket used for Darth Vader's
cloak. No, that's not a lightsaber, it's a hockey stick!

1.13 texas

Out Of The Basement, Into The Attic: The Texas Instruments Reunion Concert

Another in the genre of 'fake band rockumentaries' like 'This Is Spinal Tap',
'The Rutlles' and others.

1.14 scrollquest

Scrollquest marked FBN's entry into high tech production. The entire musical
score was composed by me (Giark) and produced using the Amiga. Another
member of the FBN team made his presence known in Scrollquest: The Master,
who plays Lex Farslayer.

ScrollQuest is the story of a group of young barbarians who must try to
recover the scroll of doom.

Cost: \$15 Cdn.

1.15 rocket

Rocket Commandos is yet another technological leap for the FBN crew. The special effects are being produced using rendering technology which is also used on tv shows and movies, such as Babylon 5, SeaQuest and Jurassic Park.

Rocket Commandos is currently on hold due to production difficulties and other technical considerations.

1.16 vampire

Vampire!

Currently in pre-production, Vampire! is the next FBN movie. It will be shot in the summer of 1996 and should be released by September '96.

1.18 therapy

Name: Therapy

Type: Game

Info: Therapy is a copy of an old VIC-20 program of the same name. It has been enhanced by graphics and synthesized speech. You'll enjoy playing with Dr. Synthetic Freud.

This game is freeware.

1.19 blackjack

Name: Blackjack For The Master

Type: Game

Info: The Master was trying to write a blackjack program and was having a bit of difficulty so I cobbled together this one for him. After he had checked out the source, I compiled it and released it under the FBN label. The game is fairly simple, with quite impressive card graphics.

This game is freeware.

1.20 banner

Name: Banner

Type: Utility

Info: Banner is another copy of a VIC-20 program. It uses an IFF picture of a character set to produce 80 column high banners on your printer.

This utility is freeware.

1.21 dungeon

Name: Dungeon

Type: Game

Info: Dungeon is an over the modem game (registered version) similar to those found in the early days of computing. You and your opponent are in a large arena filled with monsters and treasures. Your object is to kill the other player before he kills you.

This game is cardware.

1.22 solotrek

Name: SoloTrek

Type: Game

Info: SoloTrek is a Star Trek combat simulator with several difficulty levels and digitized sounds. The graphics are fair and the game play is

quite smooth.

This game is freeware.

1.23 demo

Name: CyberSpace BBS Demo

Type: Demo

Info: Created as an ad for

CyberSpace BBS

, this program contains

rendered screens and objects, plasma effects and two original MODs:
ST-NightGroove and Winky Commander.

This demo is freeware.

1.24 lunar

Name: Lunar Conquest

Type: Online Game

Info: Lunar Conquest is based on an Atari ST game. It has been tested on
the CNet 3.0+ BBS and runs quite well.

This game is shareware.

1.25 inform

Name: Inform Tool

Type: Utility

Info: Inform tool is a utility to aid in the use of the Inform Compiler
which is used to write Infocom type games.

This utility is freeware.

1.26 reminder

Name: Reminder

Type: Nagger/Reminder

Info: Reminder is an appointment book which runs under intuition and keeps
track of your important events and reminds you of them.

This utility is freeware.

1.27 dungeonv2

Name: Dungeon V2

Type: Game

Info: Another follow-up, Dungeon V2 is a major upgrade to the limited but still fun

Dungeon

. Dungeon V2 features custom files for different maps to be used for play and the setting of other goals. Full ansi color and graphics are supported. As before, the other player need only have an ANSI terminal program to play the game.

Included in the Dungeon V2 archive is the

Classic

module. This allows game

play similar to that of the original Dungeon. Additional modules

are being

created every day.

This game is shareware with a cost of \$15.

1.28 dungeonv2mod

At this point, there is no map creator for Dungeon V2, so all the ←
modules are

coming direct from FBN's programming division. If enough interest is generated, a Map Creator program will be created and sent to all registered users.

1.29 classic

The original Dungeon map lives on in the Dungeon V2 Classic module. It's a ten by ten map with all the monsters, potions, weapons and armour faithfully reproduced from the original Dungeon game.

This module is included with the Dungeon V2 archive.

1.30 alienderelict

You're stuck on an alien ship packed with monsters from SciFi movies. Grab a weapon and start blasting! Find the code key and get into an escape pod to win this challenging game. This module includes a custom sound file and an intro music module.

This module is shareware at a cost of \$2 and requires the Dungeon V2 archive to work.

1.31 changku

Alone in the ancient ruins of the Lom Ku god, you find yourself beset by archeologists, graverobbers and other foes as you struggle to clean up the temple grounds and appease the gods. But watch out! The gods are just itching to kill those who fail them, or desecrate their temples!

This module is shareware at a cost of \$2 and requires the Dungeon V2 archive to work.

1.32 houseoffright

Five stories high, from basement to attic, the house of your ancestors will be yours, if you can find the will. As if that wasn't enough, the damned place is haunted! Ghosts, devils and demons hound you at every turn as you scramble through the hallways, in search of the will.

This module is shareware at a cost of \$2 and requires the Dungeon V2 archive to work.

system has been streamlined. The game will link over the modem to allow
players to go head to head.

Name: BabCom 5

Type: Utility

Info: I recently acquired the entire episode list and info on them for the Babylon 5 series. The program is complete. I am just formatting the text for display.

This utility will be freeware.

1.38 bjii

Name: Blackjack II

Type: Game

Info: I hate AGA! Well, not really, but I wish I could play Klondike Solitaire. With that in mind, I've created Blackjack II. It has two decks to choose from at this point: Sports Illustrated and Playboy. There may be a modem option.

This game will be freeware.
