Comments : If you are starting the BRET-HAWNES virus it copies

itself always to the same memory-address \$7F000. After that it installs a new intrerrupt in the Zero-Page (\$6C). To stay resident it uses the KICK Vectors & to infect other disks it finally patches

the OpenNewLib()-Vector.

If you are now booting with an unprotected disk the virus creates the virusfile in the ${\tt ROOT-Dir}$ with

the name: \$C0A0E0A0C0.

(If you make a dir you can see strange signs !!) Then it modifies the Startup-Sequence with the

virusname.

After 20 Minutes the virus gives out a message which says the following (over the new \$6C interrupt!):

Virus Info Base 2 / 2

GUESS WHO'S BACK ??? YEP. BRET HAWNES BLOPS YOUR SCREEN I'VE TAKEN THE CONTROLL OVER YOUR AMIGA!!!

THERE'S ONLY ONE CURE: POWER OFF AND REBOOT!!!!

After the 10th infection tracks will be damaged.
