If you're starting it the trojan renames the following

directories by appending one space character to the end of the following:

```
"sys:libs"  into  "sys:libs "  
"sys:l"     into  "sys:l  "  
"sys:devs"  into  "sys:devs "  
"sys:fonts" into  "sys:fonts "
```

You see, very primitive. Just rename the directories if your disk or harddisk don't boot-up.
