Virus Information Base (VIB) is a exactly what the title says. A database from where you can get information of vira of any type. Perhaps you have wanted to know how a certain virus hides in memory or you might be seeking information on a virus which have trashed your BBS or harddisk.

VIB have very anvanced search functions and contains a lot of grabbed IFF pictures of real Amiga viruses. The virus pictures are grabbed from infected Amigas, and you will see these nasty ones JUSTas your own Amiga have been infected.

Futher more you will find some few animated virus demos in VIB to demonstrate a real virus infection of these viruses, (Please see the Amiga Knights, BGS9 and the Terrorists viuses!)

HOW TO INSTALL VIB TO YOUR HARDDISK

If you want to use the VIB from your harddisk, then you have do the following:

- 1. Copy the VIB drawer and the VIB.info files for example to your DHO: partition.
- 2. Take a text editor and add the following text to your harddisk s/startup-sequence:

Assign Virus: DHO:VIB/VirusDescriptions

Assign V-IFF: DHO:VIB/VirusIFF

3. But if you have got this Virus Info Base version from "The New Superkillers" disk, please remember that all files are packed on this disk. Of course you can decrunch all the files on the disk, but a better solution will be to transfer all the packed files to your harddisk together with the decrunch tools on our disk.

If you want to use VIB from "The New Superkillers" you have to copy the following files to your harddisk:

AmigaGuide.library to Libs: Powerpacker.library to Libs: Explode.libray to Libs: Earlyexplode to C:

And add this line to your startup-sequence: EarlyExplode >nil:

4. Please remember, that you >>>MUST<<< have the Amigaguide.library in your Libs/dir. VIB have been successful tested with the following library versions:

Version 34.11 (62.932 bytes) Version 34.8 (62.996 bytes) Version 39.11 (24.800 bytes) Version 40.4 (22.020 bytes)

IMPORTANT! Older versions will NOT...run correct!!!

SOME LITTLE TIPS

Virus Info Base have been tested at Workbench 1.3, 2.0, 2.1, 3.0, 3,1 on the following Amiga types: Amiga 500, Amiga 600, Amiga CDTV, Amiga 1200, Amiga 3000, Amiga 4030, Amiga 4040.

BUT PLEASE PAY ATTENTION

If you have the ReqChange (1.15) program installed on you harddisk you can't run VIB without problems

Do you have the old Kickstart 1.3 you can ONLY...use the Amigaguide.library 34.xx types!

The VIB icon have the default to use the Amigaguide. Please be aware if you want to run "Multiview", then you have the change VIB icon as stated in the following:

- 1. Find the pull-down menu in the top of the screen
- 2. Choose the icon/information menu
- 3. Delete the icon default (Amigaguide) in the comment gadget and write Multiview.

HOW TO DIRECTLY FIND A DESCRIPTION OF A VIRUS.

When you have started VIB either from the CLI or Workbench you are presented with the main screen. The top 28 gadgets represent a directory where the descriptions of the vira lies. Let's say you want information on the virus 'Northstar'. You would then press the gadget with the letter 'N' in it or as a shortcut press 'n' on your keyboard. You will now see a list of the directory 'Virus:N' with the names of the vira which starts with an 'N' (basic enough :-). Left is to press a gadget with a name and the description will be showed in AmigaGuide format.

1.8 How to use the virus info base program

HOW TO SEARCH FOR A VIRUS

In the menu there is a function which is called 'Global Search' (LEFT AMIGA-G). If you select this you will be presented by a small window with two string gadgets.

Here you can search for strings within the files of the assign 'Virus:'. Lets say you would like to see all the descriptions of the vira which are very dangerous. First you write 'very dangerous' into the top string gadget. You do not need to write anything in the bottom gadget but if you do both strings must be found in a file before there is a match. To search for something you MUST write something in the top gadget.

After this type of search has ended and there were matches a window will pop up and show those descriptions, which matched with the string(s) you entered. You can now click on a name and you will see the description in the text viewer. If you click cancel you will not have to search for them again. You can just choose 'List matches' (LEFT AMIGA-1) from the menu and the window with the matching descriptions will pop up again.

If you press the 'Search for name' gadget and it is activated you are searching for a file with exactly that name and not within the file. The bottom string gadget will then be ignored.

If a description with that name was found it will be loaded and shown in the text viewer.
