

Fold Edit

INTRODUCTION

Welcome to *Fold Edit*.. This utility is designed to help programers who work on the same project to “fold” their changes into the master copy of their group’s project.

This application is the partner to the *Fold Machine*. It is designed to accept exports from the *Fold Machine*. Use those exports to present the user with the differing text files. *Fold Edit* is a simple text editing application with some features perfect for text file folding.

The problem this application addresses is that of having of list of the different text files and having to open them up, put both windows on the screen so you can see them, compare the windows, and move on to the next pair of files.

The fastest way to figure it out is set the *Fold Machine* to product a Fold Edit Export and then run *Fold Edit*, do the command Open Fold... and go from there.

Many more features are in the works. Your suggestions are always welcome.

HISTORY

This product started out as a compliment to the *Fold Machine* version 2.1. Version 1.2 was a stable release of 1.1.

IMPORTANT COMMANDS

Open Fold...

This is the command to open the export that the *Fold Machine* has prepared. Use this command to begin a fold process.

Compare

This is the command to compare the text in the top two open files. It will highlight the first differences that it finds in the files.

Tile Windows

This will place the top two windows next to each other so that they fill the entire screen. Most of the time you will not need this command, it is executed automatically when a set of files to fold are opened.

Next Fold File

This command will grab the next set of files to be compared in the list. If there are none left it will tell you. Use this command when you are finished with the two files in front of you.
