
How It Works

The Dots Screen Saver basically works by randomly selecting points around the screen and placing a random coloured dot there. It then clears the screen after a certain amount of dots have been drawn on the screen.

Both the speed of the dots being draw on the screen and the amount of dots draw before the screen is cleared can be set in *the configuration window*.

The Configuration Window

Here is the configuration window click on the different parts to find out what the do:



Registering

Speed

This determines the speed that the dots appear after each other.

Number of Dots

This is the number of dots that appear before the screen is cleared.

OK Button

This saves your changes and exits the configuration window.

Cancel Button

This looses your changes and exits the configuration window

Test Button

This tests the screen saver with your new settings.

Help Button

This brings up this help file.
