Seal Of Partnership Screen Saver

A screen saver for Microsoft Windows 3.1

Installation

The installation of this screen saver is very simple. Simply follow the instructions below.

Setup Program

- 1) Insert the screen saver diskette into drive A:
- 2) Select 'Run...' from the 'File' menu and type 'A:SETUP'
 The SETUP program will copy the files to the appropriate directories
- Now configure the screen saver using the Windows 'Control Panel' application.
 - 1) Start 'Control Panel', which is in the 'Main' group of the Program Manager.
 - 2) Double click the 'Desktop' icon.
 - 3) Select the 'Seal Of Partnership' screen saver from the list.
 - 4) Press the 'Setup...' button to configure the screen saver. (See the next section).

Manual Installation

- Copy the screen saver SS.SCR and SS.EXE from the diskette to your Windows directory (For exmaple: COPY A:SS.SCR C:\WINDOWS or use the Window File Manager).
- 2) Copy the CTL3D.DLL file from the diskette to your Windows SYSTEM directory (For example : COPY A:CTL3D.DLL C:\WINDOWS\SYSTEM or use the Window File Manager).
- 3) Now configure the screen saver using the Windows 'Control Panel' application.
 - 1) Start 'Control Panel', which is in the 'Main' group of the Program Manager.
 - 2) Double click the 'Desktop' icon.
 - 3) Select the 'Seal Of Partnership' screen saver from the list.
 - 4) Press the 'Setup...' button to configure the screen saver. (See the next section).

Configuration

The 'Seal Of Partnership Screen Saver' has a number of configuration options than can be set using the Windows 'Control Panel'.

- Boeing 747 airspeed
 This is the speed at which the K.L.M. and N.W.A. Boeings
 'fly' across the screen. The value you specify should be
 between 1 (very slow) and 32 (very fast).
- Alternate enlarge of 'seal'
 This screen saver supports two methods of enlarging the Seal Of Partnership bitmap to it's full size.
 - The default method will 'blowup' the bitmap until it reaches it's full size. This has a nice effect, but can be slow on slow machines or machines that do NOT have an accelarator card (video card especially made to speed up Windows).
 - The 'alternate' method will increase the visible part of the Seal Of Partnership until it is completely visible.
 This method is less nice, but is much faster on slow machines or on machines that do NOT have an accelarator card.

If the checkbox is on (e.g. checked), the screen saver will use the 'alternate' method. Simply try each method and see which one has the best effect on your machine.

- Password protected

If the checkbox is on (e.g. checked), the screen saver is password protected. This means that whenever the screen saver is active and you want to continue working in Windows, a dialog appears that will prompt you for your password. This can be used to make sure that someone else cannot use your PC while you are out and your screen saver is active.

You can use the 'Change...' button to change the screen saver password. You will have to enter the old password followed by the new password. You also have to 'retype' the new password to make sure that you did not make any typing erros.

Starting the screen saver from the desktop

You can also start the screen saver by double clicking on the screen saver icon that is in one of the program manager groups on your desktop. Follow the instructions below if you want to be able to do this (you can start the screen saver manually at any time you like e.g. going for a cup of coffee).

- Copy the screen saver SS.EXE from the diskette to your Window directory if you did not already do so (For example : COPY A:SS.EXE C:\WINDOWS or use the Windows File Manager).
- 2) Create a program item in the program manager group of your choise and enter 'SS.EXE /s' in the command line textbox. Make sure you do NOT forget the '/s'.
- 3) You now have an icon that can be double clicked to start the screen saver from your desktop at any time you like.
