1.3 WorldMap 1.0. Registration

To register your copy of WorldMap switch on your printer and double-click the icon named 'Registration.print', fill it out and send it to me along an euro-cheque,postal money order or cash. Don't send stamps, war bonds or Eurodisney discount coupons. (Does it sound greedy enough?)

Don't even try to send bank drafts or private checks unless you are disgustingly rich, 'cause commissions are very high.

The preferred way is of course the following one:

The list will show two different kinds of information:

A list of the selected countries or the information corresponding to the current country and its flag (if available).

The main display will show a country (if available), a continent, (if available) or the whole world.

Save Shows a requester asking for a filename to save the current map as an IFF file.

Print Sends to the printer the contents of the list.

Worldmap is an open program. you can add your own countries, information and data in a very easy way.

The only thing you have to do is place the files you have created in the right drawers.

Adding Country pictures

Let's imagine we want to add a country called United Kingdom to the program so we create a pic in Dpaint (of the map) with the palette provided (palette.worldmap), then we call it 66.country, being 66 the number of the country.

You can also find this list in the DIY directory.

then we place it in the drawer called 'pics/numberofcontinent' being 1 the number of continent of the United Kingdom, so the complete path would be ...worldmap/pics/1/66.country
