## 1.10 Keyboard Workstation

The GEM WS2 - Keyboard/Workstation

This one was so expensive that we'll tell you a little more about it.

The Problem uses this device to compose their melodylines.  
 They also use it to find out what chords the victims in case of a replication use. The sounds of the keyboard is often sampled if samples couldn'd be sampled from the original source. Thanks to GEM!

The GEM WS 2 Keyboard/Workstation is a now somewhat aged Keyboard with some intelligent stuff in it to make it Workstation. It has 61 lightweight fullsize keys. There are 128 sounds in it (to wich you can add another 128). It knows 61 drumsounds, 96 global settings, 32 built in drum patterns and 32 realtime effects. There is a pitchball, a soundmixing system, MIDI support, a Disk Drive Option, a (5 way) split function, a 16 note polyphone, a sequencer (with chain composer), an alpha dial, an audio in/out connection, a 2\*20 Watt built in speaker set and a lot more.

This was probably very boring, but we had to put it in, sorry!

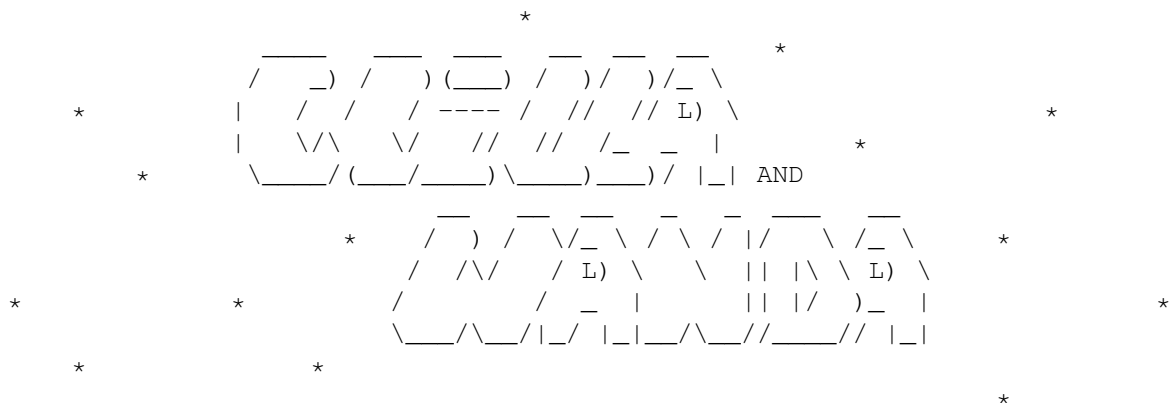
