

Taber

This program will take any text document, and replace all blank spaces with tabs; particularly handy if you are trying to laser print tables etc. created without tabs.

Spacer 1.0

This program finds carriage returns and replaces them with spaces. VERY handy for downloaded ASCII documents that were first opened with MS Word, and have carriage returns imbedded at the end of every line. If the program sees a single Return, it replaces it with a space; if it sees two or more carriage returns in a row (block paragraph style), it leaves them alone.

Spacer 1.0a

Works the same as v 1.0 except that it also looks for lines which begin with a period at the left margin (as is often the case with files downloaded from mainframes which use "dot commands" for formatting printing options). Completely erases lines which begin with a period.
