Installation

I'll describe the installation process in three steps:

- 1: Create the subdirectory and copy files
- 2: Installing "Sky" in the windows 3.0 Program Manager
- 3: Configuring "Sky" for your location

First, copy all files from the distribution disk into a directory called "SKY". To do this from DOS type:

CD \<ENTER>

MD SKY<ENTER>

CD SKY<ENTER>

COPY A:*.*<ENTER> (If you have more than one disk, insert each one and repeat this command)

If you downloaded this from a BBS then from DOS type:

CD \<ENTER>

MD SKY<ENTER>

CD SKY<ENTER>

PKUNZIP source-path \SKYW10R.ZIP<ENTER>

Next, from window's "Program Manager", select $\underline{\mathbf{File}}$ then $\underline{\mathbf{New}}$. In the Filename Box type: $\SKY\SKY.EXE$

Then press **Ok**.

Finally, select the icon for "SKY" and run it. Once "SKY" is running select **Local** then **Location** and scan through the list box for a city near your location (if you can't find one you'll have to find your location on a map and enter it into the Latitude, Longitude, and Time Zone boxes.) Once these are set select Display then **Save Defaults**. "Sky" is installed.
