1. Backwards compatibility to Beta Release 2 should exist. Save files created prior to Beta Release 2 will not load properly.

2M Memory. 1.4M disc space. Microsoft Windows 3.1.

TO THE BETA TEST TEAM

The is planned to be the final beta version of WinBridge, but plans have been known to change.

New features include:

Take back trick: this lets you replay a trick but is only available from the lead until the winning card is shown.

Window size is now remembered so you can set the size to suit your display and the game will restart at the same size.

The bidding buttons have been reduced in size so that VGA users don't have to stand on their heads to read their hand.

The played cards no long leave a piece of the baise on the displayed hands.

The help file now describes the possible opening leads.

Rubber bidding will take account of part scores. (The previous version was supposed to but there was a bug that no-one noticed.)

Duplicate score is now enabled. I'm really not sure why I disabled it.

There is no context sensitive help, but I am think of how this might be achieved.

As always, all comments (cruel and kind) and any bugs or bad bidding/play should be reported, with a copy of the save file if appropriate.
