Create My Life Window

The Create My Life Window is where new My Life databases are created. Enter a unique name or description, up to 50 characters in length, and click on the 'Create My Life' button to create a new database. A password can be assigned to the database at this time. After the database is created, the My Life Window will be displayed.

The CREATE MY LIFE button will create the new My Life database.

The EXIT button will close the window and return to the Main window.

Add Password Window

A password can be assigned to a newly created My Life database Once a password is assigned, then the password must be entered every time the database is opened. If the password is unknown or forgotten, then the My Life database can not be opened.

The ADD button will assign the password to the new database.

Open My Life Database Window

The Open My Life Window is where existing My Life databases are listed and can be opened. Open a database by selecting it and clicking on the 'Open My Life' button OR by double-clicking on the database entry If the My Life database is password protected, then a password prompt will be displayed. If there is only one database, then it is automatically opened. When a database is opened, the My Life Window is displayed.

The OPEN MY LIFE button will open the selected database.

The EXIT button will close the window and return to the Main window.

Get Password Window

If the selected My Life database is password protected, a prompt for the password will be displayed. The selected database will not be opened unless the correct password is entered.

The CHECK button will validate the password entered. If the password is valid, then the database is opened.

The background color used on windows can be changed. The default background color is white. Any changes to the background color will be saved and used the next time the My Life database is opened.

The OK button will assign the selected background color, close the window and return to the My Life window.

The CANCEL button will close the window and return to the My Life window.

Calendar Window

The Calendar Window displays which days have diaries. A date can be selected and the diary for the selected date can then be created or modified. Multi-media scrapbook elements (pictures, sounds, movies) can also be edited from the Calendar Window.

The background color of dates will be different colors depending on what scrapbook elements have been already assigned to the dates. Dates with diaries will have a yellow background color.

Dates with movies will have a green background color. Dates with pictures will have a light blue background color, Dates with sounds will have a dark blude background color. The current date will have a red background color. If a date contains multiple types of scrapbook elements, then the background color will be light purple.

The DIARY button will open the diary and display the Diary Window for the selected date.

The MOVIE button will display the Movie Window and list all movies for the selected date.

The PICTURE button will display the Picture Window and list all pictures for the selected date.

The SOUND button will display the Sound Window and list all sounds for the selected date.

The EXIT button will close the window and return to the My Life window.

The Find Window provides the capability to find diaries and/or letters that match specific search criteria. The diaries and letters can be searched for by their creation date, last modification date, and/or keywords. Multiple keywords can be specified, each word separated by a space is considered a keyword. When keywords are specified, all diaries and letters are searched to see if they contain the keyword(s). For letters, the letter description field is also searched for the keyword(s).

The FIND button will begin the search of the diaries and/or letters using the specified search criteria.

The EXIT button will close the window and return to the My Life window.

The various reports can be selected to be printed or print previewed. A report is selected when an 'X' appears in its box. Record selection criteria can be specified by selecting the Use Criteria box and then changing the FROM and TO dates. Only records with dates between the FROM and TO dates will be printed or previewed. If the Use Criteria box is unselected (the default), then all records are printed or previewed.

The PRINT button will print the selected reports to the default Windows printer.

The PRINT PREVIEW button will display the selected reports in the Print Preview Window.

Select Print Options Window

The current print options in effect are displayed. Theses options can be changed by clicking on the check boxes and toggling the options on and off. An option is on (enabled) if an 'X' appears in its check box.

There are two General Print Options that affect all reports. The *Print 'No Records Found' for empty reports* option determines if 'No Records Found' will be printed if no records for a selected report are found. The *Display pictures as frames on Print Preview* option determines whether pictures are displayed normally or as frames (boxes). Displaying pictures as frames speeds up document display and reduces memory consumption used by My Life.

There are two Diary Print Options that affect the printing of diary reports. The *Print Title* option determines if a title will be printed at the top of the first page of each diary. The title will consist of the name of the diary and the date of the diary. The *Print Cover Page* option determines if a cover page will be printed before each diary.

There are two Letter Print Options that affect the printing of letter reports. The *Print Title* option determines if a title will be printed at the top of the first page of each letter. The title will consist of the description of the letter and the date of the letter. The *Print Cover Page* option determines if a cover page will be printed before each letter.

FILE

EXPORT ... -- Export document to a file. The following file formats are supported: HighEdit, Ansi/Ascii, Ansi/Oem, and Rtf 1. The HighEdit format retains all document formatting.

IMPORT ... -- Import a file, any existing document data will be overwritten with the file data.

The following file formats are supported: HighEdit, Ansi/Ascii, Ansi/Oem, and Rtf 1.

SAVE -- Save the current changes to the document.

short-cut keys: *shift+F12* or *shift+F3*

SAVE AS -- Save the current letter as a new letter to the Letter table. The Letter description can be changed. The current letter will be unaffected. This option is only available for Letters.

SAVE PROFILE -- Save the current word processor profile settings. These saved settings will be used next time a document is edited.

PRINT -- Print the document, using the default Windows printer.

RULER -- Toggle displaying the ruler on and off.

SPACES -- Toggle displaying spaces on and off.

STATUS LINE -- Toggle displaying the status line on and off.

TAB BAR -- Toggle displaying the tab bar on and off.

TABS -- Toggle displaying tabs on and off.

TOOL BAR -- Toggle displaying the My Life tool bar on and off.

GRAY BACKGROUND -- Toggle gray background on and off.

UNITS METRIC -- Use metric system for the ruler, i.e. centimeters.

UNITS US -- Use US system for the ruler, i.e. inches.

FILE -- Insert a text file at the current cursor location. Displays the 'Insert File' dialogue which allows a file to be inserted. The following file formats are supported: HighEdit, Ansi/Ascii, Ansi/Oem, and Rtf 1.

PICTURE -- Insert a picture at the current cursor location. Displays the 'Insert Picture' dialogue which allows a picture to be inserted. The following picture formats are supported: Bmp, Pcx, Gif, Tiff, Targa, and Wmf.

FONT

FONT -- Set font information for the selected text. Displays the 'Replace Font' dialogue which allows changing the font, font size, font color, and font attributes.

MARGINS -- Set document format. Displays the 'Document Format' dialogue which allows changing the document's width, height, default tabs, and page margins.

PARAGRAPH -- Set paragraph format. Displays the 'Paragraph' dialogue which allows changing the paragraph's margins, alignment, line spacing, default tabs, and special tabs. TABS -- Set paragraph format. Displays the 'Paragraph' dialogue which allows changing the paragraph's margins, alignment, line spacing, default tabs, and special tabs. TEXT -- Format the document using the current margins.
